





KNIT SKILL LEVEL **EASY**

What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball 9263 Cinnabar

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 4.5mm [US 7]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4'' (10 cm): 22 rows = 4'' (10 cm) in St st.**CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use** any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Road Trip Mitts

These mitts are the perfect project for a road trip! They don't take up much lap space. Depending on how long your trip is, you'll have a new set of wristers to wear or give as a hostess gift once you're there!

Mitts measure 83/4" (22 cm) circumference x 9" (23 cm) long.

MITTS (make 2) Cuff

Cast on 37 sts. Rows 1-8: Knit.

Mitt

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Rows 3-4: Knit (ridge formed).

Rows 5-8: Repeat Rows 1-4.

Rows 9-11: Knit.

Row 12: Knit.

Row 13: Purl.

Rows 14-19: Repeat Rows 12 & 13.

Rows 20-21: Knit.

Row 22: Knit.

Row 23: Purl.

Rows 24-25: Knit.

Rows 26-29: Repeat Rows 22-25.

Row 30: Knit.

Row 31: Purl.

Rows 32-35: Repeat Rows 30 & 31.

Rows 36-37: Knit.

Row 38: Knit.

Row 39: Purl.

Rows 40-43: Repeat Rows 38 & 39.

Rows 44-48: Knit.

Row 49: Purl.

Row 50: Knit.

Top Cuff

Rows 1-8: Knit.

Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

With yarn needle and using Mattress Stitch, sew up mitt from bottom to top for 6" (15.25 cm), Fasten off, Sew seam from top to bottom for 1" (2.5 cm) and fasten off, leaving a gap for the thumbhole. Weave in all loose ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeters; K = knit; mm = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es)
