## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Heart & Sole®:**  
1 ball each Black 3112 **A**, Ivory 3313 **B**, and Fuchsia 3900 **C**

**Susan Bates® Double Pointed Knitting Needles:** One set 2.75mm [US 2]

Stitch markers, stitch holder or waste yarn, yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 34 sts = 4" (10 cm); 36 rounds = 4" (10 cm) across Chart A. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge given.

# Nordic Pop Mitts

The Fair Isle technique is all the rage these days! These mitts show off this technique perfectly. The deep ribbing will help keep your wrists warm and the colorful pop is sure to grab attention.

**Mitts measure 7" (17.78 cm) around palm and 9½" (24.1 cm) long**  
**Mitts fit average woman's hand. For larger mitts, use size 3.25mm [US 3] needles.**

## Special Abbreviations

**m1L (make 1 left):** Insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand between stitch just worked and the next stitch on the left needle. Knit this strand through the back loop.

**m1R (make 1 right):** Insert left needle from back to front under horizontal strand between stitch just worked and the next stitch on the left needle. Knit this strand through the front loop.

## LEFT MITT Cuff

With **A**, cast on 60 sts. Distribute sts evenly across 3 double-pointed needles. Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker to indicate beginning of round. Work in K2, P2 rib until cuff measures 4" (10 cm).

## Hand

**Rounds 1-2:** Knit around.

**Round 3:** K37, place marker, k to end of round.

## Thumb Gusset

Begin working from charts and increasing for Thumb gusset as follows:

**Setup Round:** M1R, place marker; join **B** and work Chart **A** three times to marker, slip marker; work Chart **B** to end of round.

**Note:** The st between the beginning of round marker and first marker is the first st of the Thumb gusset.

**Round 1:** Work Left Thumb chart to marker, slip marker, work next round of Chart **A** to next marker, slip marker, work next round of Chart **B** to end of round. Repeat Round 1 until you have worked all 12 rounds of Chart **A**.

Cut **B** and join **C**.

Repeat Round 1, working Left Thumb chart, Chart **A**, and Chart **B** as established, until you have worked all rounds of Left Thumb chart.

**Next round:** Place Thumb Gusset sts on st holder or waste yarn. Cast on 2 sts in their place. Continue working Chart **A** and Chart **B** as established, working 2 sts across gap according to Chart **B** - 62 sts.

When you have worked all rounds of Chart **A**, cut **C** and join **B**.

Work Chart **A** and Chart **B** as established until you have worked all rounds of Chart **A**. Cut **B**.

## Mitt Top

\*With **A**, knit 1 round.

**Dec Round:** K3, [k2tog, K2] 14 times, K3 - 48 sts.

**Next round:** Knit.

Join **C**, but do not cut **A**.

With **C**, knit 3 rounds. Cut **C**.

With **A**, knit 1 round.

Work in K2, P2 rib for 3 rounds.

Bind off.

## Thumb

Return thumb sts to needles, distributing evenly across 3 dpns. Join **A** and **C**.

With **A** and **C**, work across thumb sts in established color pattern, picking up 2 additional sts where Thumb joins Hand and working sts in established color pattern - 24 sts.

Work 3 more rounds in established color pattern.

With **A**, knit 1 round.

SHOP KIT



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**Dec Round:** K5, k2tog, K9, k2tog, K4 – 20 sts.

**Next round:** Knit.

With **C**, knit 3 rounds. Cut **C**.

With **A**, knit 1 round.

Work in K2, P2 rib for 3 rounds.

Bind off.

## RIGHT MITT

### Cuff

Work as for Left Mitt.

### Hand

**Rounds 1-2:** Knit around.

**Round 3:** K23, place marker, k to end of round.

**Begin working from charts and increasing for Thumb Gusset as follows:**

**Setup Round:** M1R, place marker, join **B** and work Chart **B** to marker, slip marker, work Chart **A** to end of round.

**Note:** The st between the beginning of round marker and first marker is the first st of the Thumb gusset.

**Round 1:** Work Right Thumb chart to marker, slip marker, work next round of Chart **B** to next marker, slip marker, work next round of Chart **A** to end.

Repeat Round 1 until you have worked all 12 rounds of Chart **A**.

Cut **B** and join **C**.

Repeat Round 1, working Right Thumb chart, Chart **B**, and Chart **A** as established, until you have worked all rounds of Right Thumb chart.

**Next round:** Place Thumb Gusset sts on st holder or waste yarn and cast on 2 sts in their place. Continue working Chart **B** and Chart **A** as established, working 2 sts across gap according to Chart **B**.

When you have worked all rounds of Chart **A**, cut **C** and join **B**.

Work Chart **B** and Chart **A** as established until you have worked all rounds of Chart **A**. Cut **B**.

Work the rest of the Hand and the Thumb same as Left Mitt Top from \* to end.

## FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in ends. Wet block to measurements.

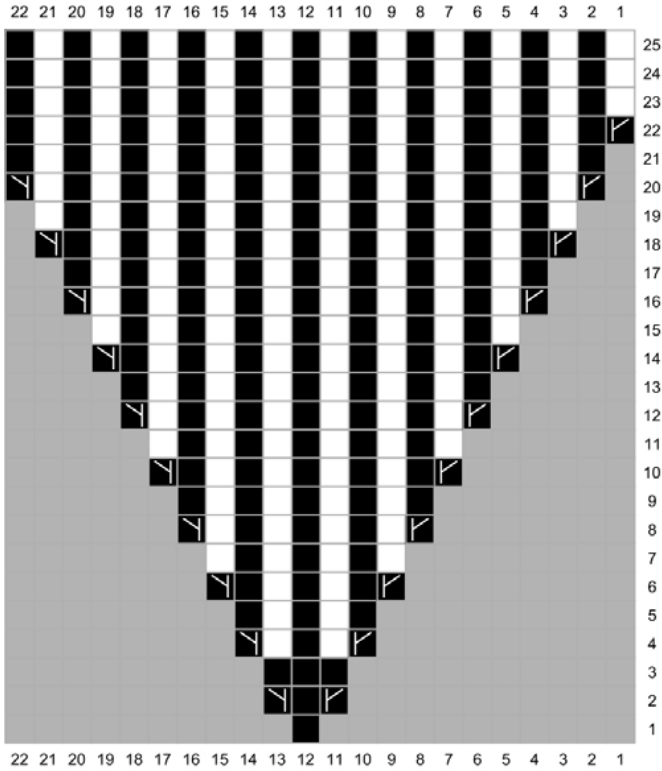
### ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Colors A, B, C; **dec** = decrease(s)(d)(ing); **inc** = increase(s)(d)(ing); **K** = knit; **k2tog** = knit the next 2 stitches together; **P** = Purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.

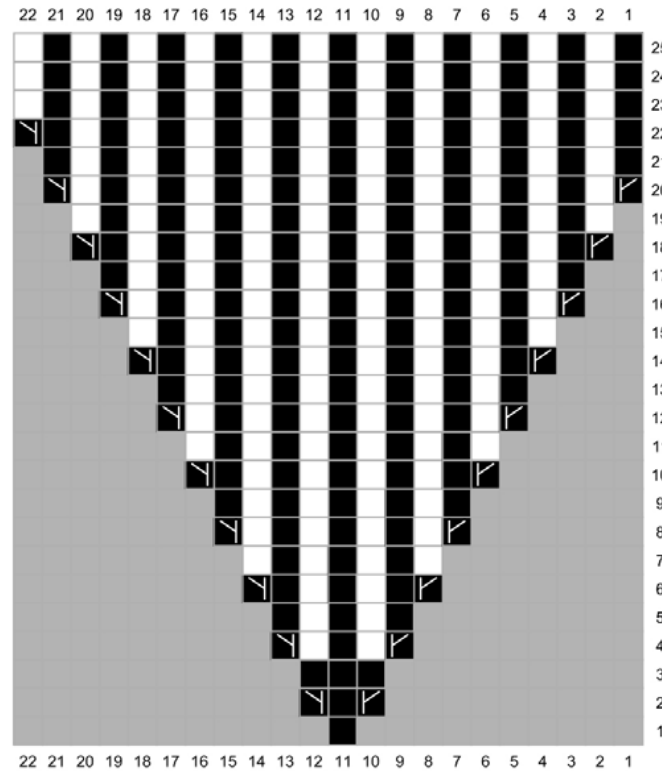
Right Thumb

- no stitch

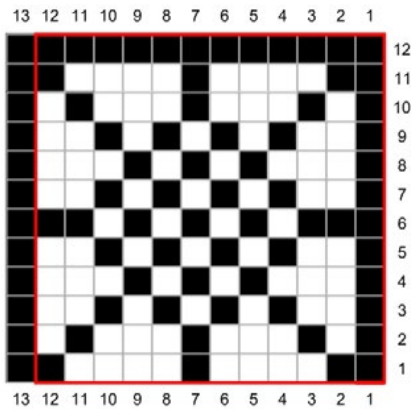
Left Thumb

- no stitch

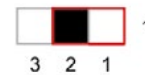
Chart A
