MATERIALS

 Red Heart® Hygge Fur™ (7 oz/200 g; 260 yds/238 m)

 Contrast A Eucalyptus (0609)
 1 ball

Red Heart[®] **Soft**[®] (5 oz/141 g; 256 yds/234 m)

Contrast B Off White (4601)

1 ball

Set of 4 size U.S. 8 (5 mm) double-pointed knitting needles or size **needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
K = Knit
K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches
together
P = Purl
Pat = Pattern
PM = Place marker

<u>SIZE</u>

One size to fit Adult. Approx 7" [18 cm] long.

GAUGE

16 sts and 23 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stripe Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

With A and B tog, cast on 28 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles (9, 9, 10) sts. Join in rnd, taking care not to twist sts. PM for beg of rnd.

1st rnd: With A, knit. **2nd rnd:** With B, knit. Rep last 2 rnds of Stripe Pat 8 times more. Rem =Remaining Rep = Repeat Rnd(s) = Round(s) RS = Right side St(s) = Stitch(es) Tog = Together WS = Wrong side

Shape Thumb Opening Note: Thumb opening, is worked in rows.

1st row: (RS). With A, knit. Drop A.
Do not join. Do not turn.
2nd row: (RS). Pick up B, and knit to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: (WS). Pick up A and purl to end of row. Do not turn.
4th row: (WS). Pick up B and purl to end of row.
Rep last 4 rows twice more.

Shape Hand

Rejoin A to work in rnds.
1st rnd: With A, knit.
2nd rnd: With B, knit.
3rd rnd: With A, (K2tog. K5) 4 times. 24 sts.



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Cuff: Next rnd: With B, (K1. P1) 12 times. Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, (alternating A and B) rep last rnd 6 times more. With A and B tog, cast off in rib.
