

KNIT CHEMO CLOCHE | KNIT

SHOP KIT



Knit Chemo Cloche

Designed by Lorna Miser

Circumference: 20 (22 1/2)".

RED HEART[®] "Light & Lofty[®]": 1 Skein 9965 Zebra Stripe

Circular Knitting Needle: 6.5mm [US 10.5] – 16". **Double Point Needles:** 6.5mm [US 10.5]. Stitch marker, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 8 sts = 4" in St st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Directions are for size Small/Medium; changes for size Medium/Large are in parentheses.

Using circular needle, cast on 40 (45) sts; join being careful not to twist stitches. Place a stitch marker on the needle to mark beginning/end of rnds.

Edging-Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: Purl. Now work in Ridge Pattern as follows:

Ridge Pattern-Rnds 4, 5, and 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: Purl.

Repeat Rnds 4-7 for Ridge Pattern until hat measures 7" from beginning, ending by working Rnd 7.

Shape Crown-Decrease Rnd 1: [K3, K2tog] 8 (9) times – 32 (36) sts.

Note: Change to double point needles when the number of sts is too small for the circular needle.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Decrease Rnd 3: [K2, K2tog] 8 (9) times – 24 (27) sts.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Decrease Rnd 5: [K1, K2tog] 8 (9) times – 16 (18) sts.

Rnd 6: Knit.

Decrease Rnd 7: [K2tog] 8 (9) times – 8 (9) sts. Cut yarn leaving a 12" tail. Thread yarn in yarn needle and through remaining sts; draw up firmly, fasten securely. Weave in ends.



RED HEART[®] "Light & Lofty[®]", Art. E708 available in solid colors – 6oz (170g), 140yd (128m) or multis and stripes – 4.5oz (127g), 105yd (96m) skeins.

ABBREVIATIONS: K = knit; mm = millimeters; P = purl; rnd = round; St st = Stockinette stitch (Knit every round.); st(s) = stitch (es); tog = together; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
