## What you will need:

### RED HEART® Super Saver®:

- 1 ball 512 Turqua A
- 1 ball 672 Spring Green B
- 1 ball 235 Lemon C
- 1 ball 706 Perfect Pink D
- 1 ball 705 Grenadine E
- 1 ball 505 Aruba Sea F
- 1 ball 506 Pool G

### Susan Bates® Knitting

Needles: 6mm [US 10]

- Red Heart® Pom and Tassel Maker
- Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 16 sts = 4" (10 cm);  
20 rows = 4" (10 cm) in  
ribbing, slightly stretched.

**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use  
any size needles to obtain the  
gauge.

# Ribbed Hat with Pompom Tassels

Your first hat or just an easy project?  
This one is perfect either way. It's great  
to make for everyone in the family or  
it's an ideal charity project.

Hat measures 18" (45.7 cm) in  
circumference (slightly stretched)

Fits most adults

## HAT

With **A**, cast on 70 sts.

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** \*Purl 2, knit 2;  
repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, purl 2.

**Row 2 (Right Side):** \*Knit 2, purl 2;  
repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, knit 2.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until work  
measures 10 inches from beginning,  
ending with a wrong side row.

## Shape Crown

**Row 1 (Right Side):** \*Knit 2, purl 2  
together (decrease 1 stitch); repeat from  
\* to last 2 stitches, knit 2 – 53 stitches.

**Row 2 (Wrong Side):** \*Purl 2, knit 1;  
repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, purl 2.

**Row 3:** \*Knit 2, purl 1; repeat from \* to  
last 2 stitches, knit 2.

**Row 4:** Repeat Row 2.

**Next Row:** \*Knit 2 together, purl 1;  
repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, knit 2 –  
36 stitches.

**Next Row:** Purl 2, \*knit 1, purl 1; repeat  
from \* to end.

**Next Row:** \*Knit 2 together; repeat from  
\* to end – 18 stitches.

**Next Row:** Purl.

**Last Row:** \*Knit 2 together; repeat from \*  
to end – 9 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long end for seaming.

Weave yarn through remaining stitches;  
gather stitches up firmly and secure.  
Sew the back seam. Starting about 3  
inches from the bottom, sew the seam  
on the reverse side, as this will be  
turned up for the brim.



## CORDS

With **B**, make cords as follows. Make  
cords 2½", 4", 6", 8 ½" and 12 ½" long,  
for a total of 5 cords.

Cast on 3 sts.

**Row 1:** Knit. DO NOT TURN WORK. Slip  
these sts back to left-hand needle.

**Row 2:** Bringing yarn firmly across the  
back of the stitches to begin, knit 3. DO  
NOT TURN WORK. Slip these sts back  
to left-hand needle.

Repeat Row 2 until cord is desired  
length. Cut yarn and draw tail through  
all three sts. Pull tight and secure end.

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## POMPOMS

Following the instructions provided with the Pom and Tassel Maker, make a 2" pompom with each of the remaining colors.

Sew a pompom to one end of each cord. Sew the other ends of the cords to the crown of the hat.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch (es);  
\* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
