# What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 1 skein 1502 Iced Aqua

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10] 16" [40.5 cm] circular needle, and one set of 6mm [US 10] double pointed needles

Stitch marker, cable needle, pompom maker (optional), yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]: 24 rounds = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette stitch (knit every round). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

# Cabled Pompom Hat

Cables all around this knit hat give it textural interest. Choose any shade of this cozy yarn to knit your own unique hat. It's a gender neutral style. Pompom is optional, of course.

**SHOP KIT** 

Directions are for size Small. Changes for size Medium are in parentheses.

To Fit Head Circumference: 20 (22)" [51 (56) cm]

Finished Circumference: 18 (20)" [45.5 (51) cm]

#### **Special Stitches**

3/3 RC (3 over 3 right cross) = Slip next 3 stitches to cable needle and hold in back, k3, then k3 from cable needle. M1P (Make 1 purl Increase) = Insert left needle from front to back under strand running between needles and purl strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole.

#### Note

Hat is worked in the round, beginning with lower ribbed band.

#### HAT

Cast on 72 (80) sts. Place marker for beginning of round. Taking care not to twist stitches, prepare to work in the round.

#### **Ribbed Band**

Rounds 1-9: \*K1, p1; repeat from \* around.

#### Body

Round 1 (increase round): \*K6. M1P. p3 (4), M1P; repeat from \* around-88 (96) sts.

Rounds 2 and 3: \*K6, p5 (6); repeat from \* around.

**Round 4:** \*3/3 RC, p5 (6); repeat from \* around.

Rounds 5-8: Repeat Rounds 2 and 3

Rounds 9-43: Repeat Rounds 2-8 five more times.

Rounds 44 and 45: Repeat Rounds 2 and 3.

#### Shape Top of Hat

Change to double pointed needles when stitches no longer fit comfortably on circular needle.

**Round 1:** \*3/3 RC, p2tog, p1 (2), p2tog; repeat from \* around-72 (80) sts.

Rounds 2-4: \*K6, p3 (4); repeat from \* around.

**Round 5:** \*K6, [p2tog] 1 (2) time(s), p1 (0); repeat from \* around-64 sts.

Rounds 6 and 7: \*K6, p2; repeat from \* around.

Round 8: \*Slip next 3 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k3, then k2tog, k1 from cable needle, p2; repeat from \* around-56 sts.

Round 9: \*K5, p2; repeat from \* around. Round 10: \*K3, k2tog, p2tog; repeat

from \* around-40 sts.

Round 11: \*[K2tog] twice, p1; repeat from \* around-24 sts.

Round 12: \*K2tog, p1; repeat from \* around-16 sts.

Round 13: \*K2tog; repeat from \* around-8 sts.

Cut varn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining stitches and pull tight to close opening at top of hat. Carefully secure end on wrong/inside of hat.

# **FINISHING**

## Pompom (optional)

Following pompom maker directions, make a 2" [5 cm] pompom and attach to top of hat. Weave in ends.

k = knit; k2tog = knit 2 stitches
together; p = purl; p2tog = purl 2
stitches together; st(s) = stitch(es);
\* = repeat whatever follows the \* as
indicated.
