





KNIT SKILL LEVEL **EASY**

What you will need:

RED HEART® Collage™: 2 balls 9983 Frozen

Susan Bates* Circular Knitting Needles: 10mm [US 15] and 12.75mm [US 17], 16" [40cm] long

Susan Bates* Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 12.75mm [US 17]

Stitch marker, pompom maker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 7.5 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 10 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette stitch using larger needles. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Fantastic Pommed Hat

When the yarn is fantastic, the hat pattern can be a really easy knit and still get rave reviews! Each ply of this yarn is dyed separately and twisted together for a wonderfully mixable wardrobe addition.

Directions are for size Small; changes for size Large is in parentheses.

Hat circumference at bottom edge: 20 (22)" [51 (56) cm]

HAT

With smaller needle, cast on 34 (38) sts. Join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Knit 5 rounds.

Change to larger needles and knit until piece measures approximately 9 (10)" [23 (25.5 cm] from beginning. Change to double pointed needles, dividing sts evenly around.

Decrease Round: [K2tog] around - 17 (19) sts.

Decrease Round: [K2tog] around to last st, k1 - 9 (10) sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to close. Secure end.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Make a large 3½" [9 cm] diameter pompom and attach to top of hat.

cm = centimeters; k = knit; k2tog = knit
2 sts together; mm = millimeters;
st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together;
[] = work directions in brackets the
number of times specified.
