# What you will need:

**RED HEART® Sweet™:** 1 ball 855 Navy

Susan Bates\* Circular Knitting Needle: 10mm [US 15], 16" [40 cm] long

Susan Bates\* Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 10mm [US 15]

Stitch markers, yarn needle

GAUGE: 6 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 9 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART\* Sweet™, Art E823 available 7 oz (200 g) 89 yds (81 m) balls



# Easy Peasy Hat

You only need one ball of this soft plush chenille yarn to make a warm comfy hat. Knit in the round on circular needles, it's perfect for an on trend accessory in a hurry! Sweet!

SHOP KIT

# Hat measures 20 (22)" [51 (56) cm] in circumference

**NOTE:** Piece is worked in continuous rounds. Place marker for beginning of round. Change to double pointed needles as sts allow, dividing sts evenly around needles.

#### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**ssk:** (1 st decrease) Slip next two stitches knitwise to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

## **HAT**

Cast on 32 (36) sts. Join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

**Rounds 1-3:** \*K1, p1; repeat from \* around. Knit 7 (12) rounds.

### For Small Size Only

**Next Round:** K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 30 sts. Knit 2 rounds.

#### **For Both Sizes**

#### **Shape Crown**

Round 1: \*K4, k2tog; repeat from \* around - 25 (30) sts.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: \*K3, k2tog; repeat from \*

around - 20 (24) sts.

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: \*K2, k2tog; repeat from \*

around - 15 (18) sts.

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: \*K1, k2tog; repeat from \*

around - 10 (12) sts.

**Round 8:** [K2tog] around - 5 (6) sts. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to close.

Secure end.



# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

cm = centimeters; k = knit; k2tog = knit
2 sts together; mm = millimeters; p =
purl; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together;

number of times specified; \* or \*\* =
