## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Boutique Twilight™:** 2 balls 9934 Electric

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needle: 8mm [US 11] and 9mm [US 13], 16" [40cm] long

**Double Pointed Knitting Needles:** 9mm [US 13]

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 15 rounds = 4" [10 cm] in Eyelet Stripe st using larger needles. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

# Eyelet Rib Slouchy Hat

This beautifully designed hat is knit with a unique chainette yarn with a little bit of sparkle. Even though the pattern may be a bit more involved than your usual project, it won't take long thanks to the jumbo weight of the yarn.

## Hat circumference at bottom edge: 22 [56 cm]

#### Note

Hat is worked in the round on circular knitting needle. Change to double pointed needles as sts allow.

#### **SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS**

**sk2p:** (2 sts decrease) Slip 1, knit 2 sts together, pass slipped stitch over. **ssk:** (1 st decrease) Slip next two stitches knitwise to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

### **PATTERN STITCHES**

**Eyelet Stripe Stitch** 

**Round 1:** \*K2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; repeat from \* to end.

Round 2: Knit.

**Round 3:** \*Yo, sk2p, yo, k5; repeat from \* to end.

Round 4: Knit.

Repeat Rounds 1-4 for Eyelet Stripe st.

#### HAT

With smaller needle, cast on 54 sts. Join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Rounds 1-4: [K1, p1] around.

Change to larger needle and knit 1 round, increasing 10 sts evenly spaced around – 64 sts

Beginning with Round 1, work Rounds 1-4 of Eyelet Stripe st for 5 times.

Shape Crown

**Decrease Round:** \*K6, k2tog; repeat from \* around – 56 sts.

Next Round: Knit.

**Decrease Round:** \*K5, k2tog; repeat from \*

around – 48 sts. **Next Round:** Knit.

Decrease Round: \*K4, k2tog; repeat from \*



Next Round: Knit.

Decrease Round: \*K3, k2tog; repeat from \*

around – 32 sts.

Next Round: Knit.

**Decrease Round:** [K2tog] around – 16 sts. **Decrease Round:** [K2tog] around – 8 sts. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to gather.

## **FINISHING**

Secure end.

Weave in ends.

#### **Abbreviations**

cm = centimeters; k = knit; k2tog = knit 2
sts together; mm = millimeters; p = purl;
st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; yo = yarn
over; [] = work directions in brackets the
number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat
whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
