

#### ORED HEART **BRAIDED CABLE KNIT HAT**

Red Heart® Super Saver® Metallic™ (5 oz/142 g; 255 yds/233 m) White (0310) 1 ball

Sizes U.S 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needles 16" [40.5 cm] long. Set of 4 size U.S. 8 (5 mm) double-pointed needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Cable needle. Tapestry needle.





# KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**C3B** = Slip next stitch onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K2, then K1 from cable needle.

**C4F** = Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. K2, then K2 from cable needle.

**C6B** = Slip next 3 stitches onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K3, then K3 from cable needle

**C6F** = Slip next 3 stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. K3, then K3 from cable needle


**Cont** = Continue(ity)

 $\mathbf{K} = Knit$ 

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

**M1** = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop





 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$ 

**Pat** = Pattern

**P2tog** = Purl next 2 stitches

together

**Rem** = Remaining

**Rep** = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

**Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

## SIZE

One size to fit adult.

# **GAUGE**

17 sts and 20 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in stocking st.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

With smaller circular needle, cast on 84 sts. Join in rnd, placing marker on first st.





# CRED HEART BRAIDED CABLE KNIT HAT

1st rnd: \*K2. P2. Rep from \* around. Rep 1st rnd for 2" [5 cm].

Switch to larger circular needle.

Increase rnd: \*K7. M1. Rep from \*
around. 96 sts.

Proceed in Braided Cable Pat as follows:

1st rnd: \*K9. P3. Rep from \* around.

2nd rnd: As 1st rnd.

**3rd rnd:** \*C6F. K3. P3. Rep from \* around.

4th to 6th rnds: As 1st rnd.

**7th rnd:** \*K3. C6B. P3. Rep from \* around.

8th rnd: As 1st rnd.

**9th to 48th rnds:** Rep 1st to 8th rnds 5 times more.

Shape crown, switching to double-pointed needles when appropriate.

**1st rnd:** \*ssk. K5. K2tog. P3. Rep from \* around. 80 sts.

**2nd rnd:** \*K7. P3. Rep from \*around.

3rd rnd: \*K7. P2tog. P1. Rep from

\* around. 72 sts.

**4th rnd:** \*C4F. K3. P2. Rep from \* around.

5th rnd: \*ssk. K3. K2tog. P2. Rep

from \* around. 56 sts.

**6th rnd:** \*K5. P2. Rep from \* around.

**7th rnd:** \*K1. C3B. P2tog. P1. Rep

from \* around. 48 sts.

**8th rnd:** \*ssk. K2. P2. Rep from \* around. 40 sts.

**9th rnd:** \*K3. P2. Rep from \* around.

**10th rnd:** \*ssk. K1. P2tog. Rep from \* around. 24 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts and draw up tightly. Fasten securely.

#### **Pompom**

Wind yarn around 4 fingers approx 80 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to smooth round shape. Attach pompom to top of Hat.
