



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**K** = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

**P** = Purl

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rem** = Remaining

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sl1Pwyib** = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in back of work

**Sl1Pwyif** = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in front of work

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

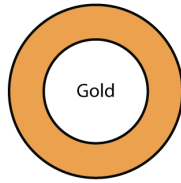
**WS** = Wrong side

## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver® O'Go™** (Solids: 7 oz/197 g; 364 yds/333 m; Prints: 5 oz/141 g; 236 yds/215 m)

**Contrast A** Newsprint (7124) **1 O'Go**

**Contrast B** Gold (7160) **1 O'Go**



Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. Yarn needle.

## SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

## GAUGE

17 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat with larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove and start knitting.
- Work from O'Go as the colors flow – no need to separate colors.

## HAT

With B and smaller needles cast on 85 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**2nd row:** \*P1. K1. Rep from \* to last st. P1.

Rep last 2 rows (K1. P1) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Place marker at end of last row.

**Note:** When working with 2 colors in a row, carry color not in use loosely across WS of work.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). With A, K2. \*Sl1Pwyib. K3. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. Sl1Pwyib. K2.

**2nd row:** With A, K2. \*Sl1Pwyif. K3. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. Sl1Pwyif. K2.

**3rd row:** With A, K2. \*With B, K1. With A, K3. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. With B, K1. With A, K2.

**4th row:** As 2nd row.

**5th row:** As 1st row.

**6th row:** With A, K2. \*With B, P1. With A, K3. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. With B, P1. With A, K2.

Rep last 6 rows for pat until Hat from marked row measures approx 6" [15 cm], ending on a 6th row of pat.

**Shape top: 1st row:** (RS). With A, K2. \*Sl1Pwyib. K1. K2tog. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. Sl1Pwyib. K2. 65 sts.

**2nd row:** With A, K2. \*Sl1Pwyif. K2. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. Sl1Pwyif. K2.

**3rd row:** With A, K2. \*With B, K1. With A, K2. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. With B, K1. With A, K2.

**4th row:** As 2nd row.

**5th row:** With A, K2tog. \*Sl1Pwyib. K2tog. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. Sl1Pwyib. K2tog. 45 sts.

**6th row:** With A, K1. \*With B, P1. With A, K1. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. With B, P1. With A, K1.

**7th row:** With A, K1. \*Sl1Pwyib. K1. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. Sl1Pwyib. K1.

**8th row:** With A, K1. \*Sl1Pwyif. K1. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. Sl1Pwyif. K1. Break A.

**9th row:** With B, K1. \*K2tog. Rep from \* end of row. 23 sts.

Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end onto yarn needle and draw tightly through rem sts. Sew center back seam, reversing seam for cuff turnback.

**Pom-pom:** Wind B around 4 fingers 100 times. Tie tightly in the middle and leave a long end for attaching to Hat. Cut loops at both ends and trim to smooth round shape. Sew securely to top of Hat.
