## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** =

Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rem** = Remaining

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**WS** = Wrong side

## SIZES

To fit 20" [51 cm] head circumference.

## GAUGE

20 sts and 25 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Rib stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### HAT

With A, cast on 100 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to end of row.

Rep 1st row for pat until work measures 4.5" [11.5 cm] from cast on edge.

Change to B, work in pat for 4 rows.

Change to C, work in pat for 8 rows.

Change to B, work in pat for 4 rows.

Change to D, work in pat until work measures 9" [26.7 cm] from cast on edge, ending on a WS row.

### Crown Shaping

**1st row:** (RS). \*K2tog. P2. Rep from \* to end of row. 75 sts.

**2nd row:** \*K2. P1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**3rd row:** \*K1. P2tog. Rep from \* to end of row. 50 sts.

**4th to 6th rows:** \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**7th row:** P2tog. \*K2tog. P2tog. Rep from \* to end of row. 25 sts.

**8th row:** K1. \*P1. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**9th row:** P1. \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**10th row:** As 8th row.

**11th row:** K1. \*K2tog. K1. Rep from \* to end of row. 17 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a 16" [40.5 cm] end. Thread yarn needle with end and weave through rem sts. Draw up firm; fasten securely.

## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver® Super Craft Kit™** Set includes 12 balls (50 g/1.7 oz each; 600 g/21 oz total), yardage (85 m/93 yds each; 1020 m/1116 yds total)

**Contrast A** Cherry Red **1 ball or 93 yds/85 m**

**Contrast B** Lavender **1 ball or 46 yds/42 m**

**Contrast C** Shocking Pink **1 ball or 46 yds/42 m**

**Contrast D** Black **1 ball or 58 yds/53 m**

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. 3½" [9 cm] piece of sturdy cardboard for pom-pom.

## FINISHING

With RS tog and matching stripes sew center back seam.

### Make Pompom

With A, B, C, and D held tog, wrap yarn around 3½" [9 cm] piece of heavy cardboard (the more wraps, the fuller the pompom). Gently remove wraps from cardboard. Cut a 12" [30.5 cm] length of yarn and tie it tightly around center of wraps. **Do not** cut the ends of this center tie. Cut ends of wraps. Fluff and trim Pompom to even strands. Use ends of center tie to attach pompom to top of Hat.
