



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

C4B = Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K2, then K2 from cable needle.

C4F = Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. K2, then K2 from cable needle.

C6B = Slip next 3 stitches onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K3, then K3 from cable needle.

C6F = Slip next 3 stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. K3, then K3 from cable needle.

Dec(s) = Decrease(s)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

P = Purl

P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches together

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

Rnd = Round

RS = Right side

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time onto right needle. Pass them back onto left needle and then knit through back loops together.

SK2P = Slip next stitch knitwise onto right-hand needle. K2tog. Pass slipped stitch over.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 333 yds/364 m)

Oatmeal (0326) **1 ball or 175 yds/160 m**

Embroidery

Anchor® Tapestry Wool (10.9 yds/10 m)

Contrast A 8804 **1 skein or 10.9 yds/10 m**

Contrast B 8456 **1 skein or 10.9 yds/10 m**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® circular knitting needle 16" [40.5 cm] long. Set of 4 size U.S. 8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® cable needle. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

SIZE

Approx 21" [53.5 cm] head circumference to fit Adult.

GAUGE

17 sts and 23 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Hat is worked in the round from bottom up starting with circular needle and changing to set of 4 double-pointed needles during shaping rows.

Cast on 100 sts. Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around. Rep last rnd of (K2. P2) ribbing for 6" [15 cm].

Proceed in Cable Pat as follows:

1st rnd: *K12. (K1. P1) 4 times. Rep from * around.

2nd rnd: *K12. (P1. K1) 4 times. Rep from * around.

3rd rnd: *C6B. C6F. (K1. P1) 4 times. Rep from * around.

4th rnd: As 2nd rnd.

5th and 6th rnds: As 1st and 2nd rnds.

7th to 12th rnds: As 1st to 6th rnds.

13th rnd: (Dec rnd): *K12. P2tog. (K1. P1) twice. K2tog. Rep from * around. 90 sts.

****Note:** Change to double-pointed needles when necessary to accommodate sts as you shape top.

14th rnd: *K12. (K1. P1) 3 times. Rep from * around.

15th rnd: *C6B. C6F. (P1. K1) 3 times. Rep from * around.

16th rnd: As 14th rnd.

17th rnd: *K12. (P1. K1) 3 times. Rep from * around.

18th rnd: As 14th rnd.

19th rnd: (Dec rnd): *K12. K2tog. P1. K1. P2tog. Rep from * around. 80 sts.

20th rnd: *K12. (P1. K1) twice. Rep from * around.

21st rnd: *C6B. C6F. (K1. P1) twice. Rep from * around.

22nd rnd: As 20th rnd.

23rd rnd: *K12. (K1. P1) twice. Rep from * around.

24th rnd: As 20th rnd.

25th rnd: (Dec rnd): *K12. P2tog. K2tog. Rep from * around. 70 sts.

26th rnd: *K12. K1. P1. Rep from * around.

27th rnd: *C6B. C6F. P1. K1. Rep from * around.

28th rnd: As 26th rnd.

29th rnd: (Dec rnd): *ssk. K8. K2tog. P1. K1. Rep from * around. 60 sts.

30th rnd: *K10. K1. P1. Rep from * around.

31st rnd: *K10. P1. K1. Rep from * around.

32nd rnd: Rep 30th rnd.

33rd rnd: (Dec rnd): *Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K3. ssk over 2 sts on cable needle. Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work. K2tog. K3 from cable needle. P1. K1. Rep from * around. 50 sts.

34th rnd: *K8. K1. P1. Rep from * around.

35th rnd: *K8. P1. K1. Rep from * around.

36th rnd: As 34th rnd.

37th rnd: (Dec rnd): *K7. SK2P. Rep from * around. 40 sts.

38th rnd: Knit.

39th rnd: *C4B. C4F. Rep from * around.

40th rnd: Knit.

41st rnd: (Dec rnd): *ssk. K4. K2tog. Rep from * around. 30 sts.

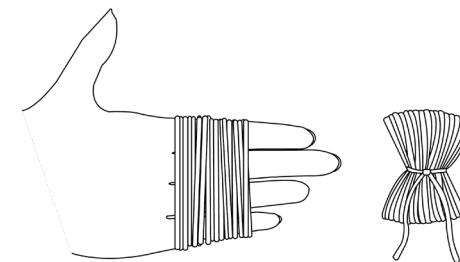
42nd rnd: (Dec rnd): *ssk. K2. K2tog. Rep from * around. 20 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a 6" [15 cm] tail. Thread tail through rem sts and pull tightly to secure.

POMPOM

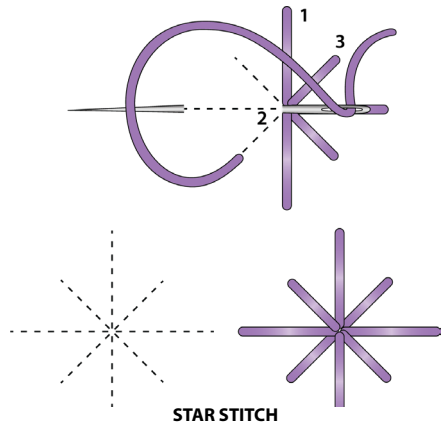
Wind yarn around 4 fingers 90 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape, approx 4" [10 cm] diameter.

Sew to top of Hat.



EMBROIDERY

Using Contrast A, embroider Star Stitch in center of each Seed St Panel around Hat.



Using Contrast B, embroider a French Knot in center of each Star.
