SHADED SCARF | KNIT



Shaded Scarf

GAUGE: 18 sts = 4"; 29 rows = 4" in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Cast on 36 sts. Rows 1 and 3 (Right Side): Knit. Rows 2 and 4: Purl. Rows 5-8: Knit. Rows 9-12: Repeat Rows 1-4. Row 13: * K2, P1, K1; repeat from * across. Row 14: * K1, P1; repeat from * across. Row 15: * P1, K3; repeat from * across. Rows 16 and 18: Purl. Rows 17: Knit. Rows 19-24: Repeat Rows 13-18. Rows 25-28: Knit.

Repeat Rows 1-28 for pattern 15 **more** times, then work Rows 1-4 once more. Bind off.

Fringe: Cut 11" strands of yarn. Holding 4 strands together, knot fringe across each end of scarf as follows: fold strands in half forming a loop; insert the crochet hook through the fabric from the wrong side and draw the loop through, then draw the yarn ends through the loop and tighten. Repeat across each end of scarf. Trim yarn ends.
