Yarn needed: RED HEART* With Love* - 1 skein 1546 Iris or color of your choice

Tools needed: Susan Bates® Knitting Needles - 6 mm [US 10] Yarn needle

What you'll do:

Slip knot

Cast on

Knit (k)

Garter stitch (knit every stitch of every row)

Check gauge

Repeat

Bind off

Weave in ends

Gauge:

14 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 44 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter stitch (knit every stitch of every row).



Beginner Knit Skinny Scarf

A Garter stitch skinny scarf is a satisfying and time-honored first project. It's easy enough that even beginners can complete this scarf.

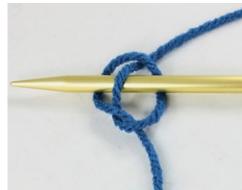
Project size: Scarf measures about 4" [10 cm] wide x 80" [203 cm] long.

PATTERN Pattern Notes

- The scarf is made by casting on stitches then working rows, knitting every stitch of every row.
- Knitting every stitch of every row is known as Garter stitch. Working in Garter stitch creates thick fabric with a pebbly appearance on both sides.

SCARF Cast on:

 Make a slip knot and place it on one needle. The slip knot counts as the first stitch.

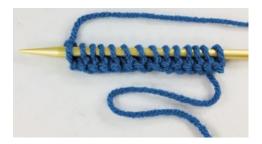


2. Cast on 13 more stitches for a total of 14 stitches on the needle.



3. **Row 1:** Knit each stitch all the way across.

SHOP KIT



Repeat Row 1 until piece measures about 80" [203 cm].





Bind off:

1. Knit 2 stitches.



Lift the second stitch from the point of the right needle over the first stitch and drop it off the needle (one stitch has been bound off).





- 3. Knit 1 stitch.
- 4. Lift the second stitch from the point of the right needle over the first stitch and drop it off the needle (one more stitch has been bound off).
- 5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 until all stitches have been knit off the left needle and there is only one stitch remaining on the right needle.



 Cut the yarn, leaving a 6" [15 cm] tail.
 Draw the tail through the last stitch, drop the stitch from the right needle, and pull on the tail to tighten.





Finishing

Using yarn needle, weave in yarn tails.
