



KNIT SKILL LEVEL EASY

What you will need:

RED HEART[®] Evermore[™]: 5 balls 9934 Emerald Isle

Susan Bates[®] Knitting Needles: 9mm [US 13]

Susan Bates[®] Crochet Hook: 9mm [US M-13]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" (10 cm) in scarf pattern. Note: There is no need to make a gauge swatch, as the piece is fairly narrow. Simply begin the pattern and check your gauge after a few rows have been completed.

Fringed Eyelet Scarf

Add a bit of greenery into your cold weather wardrobe with a gorgeous scarf. The bulky yarn and easy pattern is a fun knit! It's perfect for gifts, too!

Scarf measures 11½ x 82" (29 x 208 cm) not including fringes

SPECIAL STITCH

Ssk = slip next two stitches knitwise to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

SCARF

Cast on 29 sts, and knit 2 rows. Next 20 rows: Row 1 (wrong side): K2, p5, * k5, p5; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2. Row 2: K7, * p5, k5; repeat from * to last 2 sts. k2.

Row 3: Repeat row 1. **Row 4:** K2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, * p5, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk; repeat from * to last 2 sts. k2. Row 5: Repeat row 1. Row 6: Repeat row 2. Row 7: Repeat row 1. **Row 8:** K2, ssk, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, * p5, ssk, yo, k1, yo, k2tog; repeat from * to last 2 sts. k2. Row 9: Repeat row 1. Rows 10 and 11: Repeat row 2. Row 12: Repeat row 1. Row 13: Repeat row 2. Row 14: K2, p5, * k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, p5; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2. Row 15: Repeat row 2. Row 16: Repeat row 1. Row 17: Repeat row 2. **Row 18:** K2, p5, * ssk, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, p5; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2. Row 19: Repeat row 2. Row 20: Repeat row 1. Repeat rows 1-20 until piece measures 811/2" (207 cm) or desired length, ending with a right row. Knit 2 rows, then bind off all sts.



FINISHING Fringe

Cut 2 strands of yarn, 10" (25.5 cm) each. Fold strands at center. Use hook to pull center of strands through Scarf edge, then pull ends of strands through the resulting loop and pull tight. Attach 11 fringes in this manner evenly across each short edge of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.

Weave in all loose ends.


k = knit; k2tog = knit next 2 sts together; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **yo** = yarn over; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.

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
