# What you will need:

RED HEART® Chunky Soft™: 1 ball each 4260 Apricot A, 4601 Off White B, 4360 Cocoa C and 4604 Navy D

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needles: 8mm [US11] 29" long

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 11 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 23 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter Stitch (knit every row). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

# Market Square Striped Scarf

You can feel comfy without losing your cool in this striped easy-knit scarf.
The extra-large size and chunky thickness of the yarn give it an updated look.

Scarf measures 9" wide x 85" long [23 cm x 216 cm]

#### **NOTES**

- Scarf is worked horizontally in rows of Garter Stitch (knit every row) stripes.
- 2. Scarf is worked on circular needles to accommodate the large number of stitches, do not join.
- 3. To minimize the number of yarn ends to weave in, do not cut yarn until instructed, see "Cut Yarn".

### **SPECIAL ABBREVIATION**

**K2TOG TBL** = Knit 2 stitches together through the back loop.

#### **SPECIAL STITCH**

**Stretchy Bind-Off** = Knit 2 stitches, (transfer the 2 worked stitches to the left-hand needle and K2tog TBL, K1. Repeat across row.

## **SCARF**

With A, cast on 200 sts.

Rows 1-4: With A, knit.

Rows 5-6: With B, knit.

Row 7: With A, knit. Cut yarn.

Row 8: With C, knit. Cut yarn.

Rows 9-11: With B, knit. Cut yarn.

Rows 12-13: With D. knit.

Rows 14-15: With C, knit.

Rows 16-17: With D, knit. Cut yarn.

Rows 18-24: With C, knit. Cut yarn.

Rows 25: With B, knit. Cut yarn.

Rows 26-29: With D. knit.

Rows 30-31: With A, knit.

Rows 32-33: With D, knit. Cut yarn.

**Rows 34-35:** With **A**, knit.

Row 36: With B, knit. Cut yarn.

Rows 37-42: With C, knit. Cut yarn.

Rows 43-49: With B, knit.

Rows 50-51: With D, knit.

Row 52: With B, knit. Cut yarn.

Row 53: With C, knit. Cut yarn.

With **D**, bind off all stitches using Stretchy Bind-Off method. Cut yarn.

## **FINISHING**

With yarn needle, weave in all ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**A, B, C** = Color A, B, C; **cm** = centimeter; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es)
