What you will need:

Red Heart® Boutique Sashay Sequins™: 1 ball each 1012 Caviar A and 1101 Champagne B

Red Heart® Soft®: 1 ball 4614 Black C

Circular Knitting Needle: US 7 [4.5mm] 29" [74 cm] long

24" [60 cm] black ribbon, 1 black ribbon flower with jewel, sewing needle and black thread

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in 1 x 1 Rib with C. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Party Ruff

Sophisticated and bewitching, this ruffled accessory is perfect for partygoers. Easy to knit in just a couple hours, you'll love the sparkle the sequins add.

Ruff measure 5" [13 cm] x 12" [30.5 cm]

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

Stretch one end of Sashay open for several inches and lay it flat. Notice that Sashay is a mesh of holes with 2 different edges. Both edges have "railroad track" edges; on one edge they are much farther apart than on the other. This edge is the top; use the holes along it as if as you would yarn.

To cast on: Open mesh out for several inches. Beginning 4" [10 cm] from end, insert right needle from back to front through hole between bars on top edge—1 stitch picked up. Skipping the specified number of holes, continue picking up stitches to desired stitch count. The outer strand (one rail of track) should sit over the needle, forming the stitches. Turn work.

To knit or purl: Insert right needle through hole or stitch on needle as usual. Opening mesh with your fingers as you go and skipping specified number of holes, lay top strand of hole over right needle and draw it through hole or stitch—1 stitch worked.

Pattern Stitches

1 x 1 Rib (multiple of 2 sts + 1)

Row 1 (Right Side): *K1, p1; repeat from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: *P1, k1; repeat from * to last st, p1. Repeat these 2 rows for 1 x 1 Rib.

Garter Stitch

All rows: Knit.

Notes

1. Ruff is worked flat back and forth. Circular needle is used for greater ease working with mesh yarn.
2. A and B are held together as one throughout while working Ruffle.

RUFF

Ruffle

Holding A and B together as one and skipping 2 holes for each st, cast on 49 sts.

Skipping 2 holes, work in Garter Stitch until ruffle measures 4" [10 cm]. Cut A and B, leaving a 4" [10 cm] tail of each yarn.

Neckband

Join C. Work 1 x 1 Rib for 1" [2.5 cm]; bind off.

Finishing

Fold ends of Sashay under and sew to inside with sewing needle and thread. Weave in other ends.

Cut ribbon into 2 equal lengths. Tie a ribbon to Neckband on each side of Ruff.

With sewing needle and thread, sew flower to center front of neckband.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; k = knit; p = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
