What you will need:

RED HEART® Reflective: 3 balls 8884 Peacock

Knitting Needles: 6 mm [US 10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 26 sts = 4" (10 cm) in 2 x 2 Rib, unstretched. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.





Easy Ribbed Scarf for All

This yarn reflects the flash of a camera for an amazing way to light up your look! Choose any color of this bulky weight yarn and knit it for yourself or as a gift...perfect for a guy or gal!

Scarf measures 5½" (14 cm) wide x 56" (142 cm) long

Pattern Stitches

2 x 2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts)

Row 1 (Right Side): *K2, p2; repeat from *
to end of row.

Repeat this row for 2 x 2 Rib.

SCARF

Cast on 36 sts.

Work in 2 x 2 Rib until piece measures 56" (142 cm) from beginning, or until 1 meter (1 yard) of yarn remains.

Bind-Off Row: K2, using the tip of the left-hand needle, lift the first st on the right-hand needle up and over the second st and drop it off the needle to bind off 1 st (1 st remains on right-hand needle); [p1, bind off 1] twice, *[k1, bind off 1] twice, [p1, bind off 1] twice; repeat from * to end—1 st remains. Cut yarn, leaving a 8" (20.5 cm) tail. Thread tail through remaining st on right-hand needle and pull it gently to fasten it off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
