What you will need:

RED HEART® Stellar™: 1 ball 9804
Comet

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:
6 mm [US 10]

Yarn needle, crochet hook

GAUGE: 8 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 4
rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter Stitch.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any
size needle to obtain the gauge.

Easy Garter Stitch Scarf

*All you need to know is the knit stitch! This
Garter Stitch scarf is perfect for beginners or
when you want a new scarf in a hurry.*

Scarf measures: 4" wide x 70" long
including fringe [10 cm x 178 cm]

PATTERN STITCH

Garter Stitch

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit all sts.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Knit all sts.

Repeat rows 1-2.

SCARF

Cast on 8 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit across row.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Knit across row.

Continue working in Garter st (knit every row)
until scarf measures 50" [127 cm] or desired
length.

Next Row: Bind off all sts loosely. Draw
through remaining st twice; fasten securely.

FRINGE

Cut eight - 20" [51 cm] strands of yarn.

Fold strand in half. With crochet hook pull
doubled yarn through stitch along end edge
of scarf and feed the ends of the yarn through
the loop-pull loop tightly to secure. Repeat
along edge spacing fringe evenly — 1 strand
per stitch. Repeat on opposite end of scarf.
Trim fringe to same length.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit; **cm** = centimeters; **mm** =
millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch (es).
