

## Mitered Scarf

## Scarf measures: 6" x 61".

RED HEART® Boutique ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ "Eclipse ${ }^{\text {TM } ": ~} 3$ balls 9251 Sunset.

Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10].
Yarn needle.
GAUGE: 16 sts = 4"; 32 rows = 4" in Garter st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

NOTE: Scarf is constructed modularly in 8 triangles, see diagram.

## SCARF

## First Triangle

Cast on 63 sts.
Row 1 (Wrong Side): $K$ even across.
Row 2: K2tog, $k$ across row to center 3 sts, $k 3$ tog, $k$ to last 2 sts, k2tog-59 sts.
Rows 3-28: Repeat Rows 1 and 2-7 sts.
Row 29: K even across.
Row 30: K2tog, k3tog, k2tog-3 sts.
Row 31: K even across.
Row 32: K3tog, cut yarn and fasten off last st.

## Second Triangle

With right side facing, pick up and knit 32 sts along left side edge of previously worked triangle, cast on 31 sts onto same needle-63 sts. Work same as for first triangle.

## Third Triangle

Cast on 31 sts, with same needle and right side facing, pick up and knit 32 sts along left side edge of previously worked triangle-63 sts. Work same as for first triangle.

Continue working triangles alternately in this manner until 8 triangles have been completed.

## FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: $\mathrm{K}=$ knit; $\boldsymbol{t o g}=$ together; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters, $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=\operatorname{stitch}(\mathrm{es})$.
