



Knit Just the Thin Scarf

Scarf measures 6" x 84" without loop tassels.

RED HEART® Boutique™ "Cosmic™": 1 ball 9801 Star Blue.

Circular Knitting Needle: 4mm [US 6] – 36".

NOTE: Scarf is worked in rows across the long edge. You will be knitting the thin sections of the yarn.

SCARF

Cast on: Using only the thin sections of the yarn, cast on 44 sts; make a slip knot and then cast on a second st with the thin section, *carry the thick section loosely across the needle, then cast on 2 more sts with the next thin section; repeat from * until there are 44 sts on the needle. (22 pairs of 2 sts).

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Skip the next thin section of yarn (the 2 thick sections will fall together as a fringe), with the following thin section Purl the first 2 sts, * skip the next thick section, P2 with the next thin section; repeat from * across.

Row 2: Skip the next thin section of yarn (the 2 thick sections will fall together as a fringe), with the following thin section Knit the first 2 sts, * skip the next thick section, K2 with the next thin section; repeat from * across.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until 4 yards of yarn remain (at least 25 thick sections + yarn for weaving in end).

Bind off:

Skip the next thin section of the yarn, *knit the 2 sts on the next thin section, pass 1st stitch over 2nd stitch, draw the entire length of the remaining yarn through the st on the right needle (or the 2nd stitch) to lock in place, allowing that thin section to fall away. Repeat from * across. Weave in ends, making loop for last fringe.

ABBREVIATIONS: **K** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **St st** = Stockinette stitch (Knit on right side rows; Purl on wrong side rows.); **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
