



## Keyhole Knit Scarf

Designed by Jean Adel.

Scarf measures 8" wide x 30" long.

**RED HEART® "Curly Q":** 1 ball 7965 Calypso

**Knitting Needles:** 9 mm (US 13)  
Stitch holder, crochet hook

**GAUGE:** 10 sts = 4"; 12 rows = 4" in rib pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

### Rib Pattern (worked over an even number of sts)

**Row 1 (right side):** \* K1, p1; repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat Row 1 for rib pattern.

**Note:** Scarf is worked very loosely.

### SCARF

Cast on 20 sts.

Begin rib pattern, marking row 1 as right side, and work even until piece measures 8", ending with a wrong side row.

### Divide for slit

**Next Row:** Work in rib pattern for 10 sts, place remaining 10 sts on stitch holder for second side of slit. Turn work and continue on these 10 sts only for 4", ending with a right side row. Cut yarn and place sts on second stitch holder.

**Next Row:** Slip sts from first stitch holder back to needle and rejoin yarn to right side. Continue in rib pattern as established, and work same as for first side of slit.

### Join to end slit

**Next Row (wrong side):** Work in rib pattern to end of row; slip sts from stitch holder onto left needle, and continue in rib across—20 sts.

Work even on all sts until scarf measures 30" from beginning. Bind off loosely in rib.

### FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends.
