**What you will need:**

**RED HEART® It's A Wrap:**  
1 cake 9274 Romance

**Susan Bates® Knitting Needle:**  
3.25 mm [US 3] 24" [60 cm]  
long

Stitch markers, yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 26 sts = 4" [10 cm] in  
Garter stitch (knit every row).  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use  
any size needle to obtain the  
gauge.

# Long & Skinny Scarf

If you love super-long scarves, this one needs to be added to your to-make list! The color blocking colorways look just as great looped around a few times as it does worn long and loose.

**Finished Dimensions:** 15" (38 cm) x 90" (228 cm) when blocked

**Notes**

1. Right side rows are worked in alternating sections of Garter stitch (knit every row) and the Lace pattern. Markers are placed between sections, slip markers when you come to them.
2. When working Lace pattern over indicated number of stitches, take care to always end with k3.

**Special Stitch**

**s2kp (slip 2, knit, pass 2 slipped stitches over)** = Slip 2 stitches as if to knit 2 stitches together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over the knit stitch and off the needle - 2 sts decreased.

**Pattern Stitch**

**Lace Pattern (multiple of 10 sts + 3)**

**Row 1:** \*K3, yo, k1, yo, k3, s2kp; repeat from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

**Row 2:** Purl.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for Lace pattern.

**SHAWL**

Cast on 97 sts.

Work in Garter stitch (knit every row) for 5 rows.

**Row 1 (set-up row - right side):** K3,

place marker, work Row 1 of Lace pattern over next 23 sts, place marker, k6, place marker, work Row 1 of Lace pattern over next 33 sts, place marker, k6, place marker, work Row 1 of Lace pattern over next 23 sts, place marker, k3.

**Row 2 (wrong side):** [Knit to next marker, slip marker, work Row 2 of Lace pattern to next marker, slip marker] 3 times, knit to end of row.

**Row 3:** [Knit to marker, slip marker, work Row 1 of Lace pattern to next marker] 3 times, knit to end of row.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until you have a little more than enough yarn remaining to knit 11 more rows, end with a wrong side row (Row 2) and remove markers.

Work in Garter stitch for 5 rows.  
Bind off.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends. Block piece to finished measurements.

**ABBREVIATIONS**

**k** = knit; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
