## What you will need:

RED HEART ${ }^{\text { }}$ It's a Wrap Hues ${ }^{\text {TM }: ~} 1$ ball 9885 Cool Blue

Susan Bates ${ }^{*}$ Knitting Needles: 2.75 mm [US 2]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 25 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$; 52 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in Garter st (knit every row). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

RED HEART ${ }^{\star}$ It's a Wrap Hues ${ }^{\text {™ }}$, Art E901 available in solid color 5.29 oz (150 g), $623 \mathrm{yd}(570 \mathrm{~m})$ balls


## Dramatically Stunning Leaves Shawl

You'll love the way each leaf is added without changing the color of your yarn. Just one continuous ball of yarn is all you need to make this striking accessory!

Shawl Measures 42" (106.5 cm) across neck edge and 20" ( 51 cm ) in length at longest point.

Final size may vary due to variations in the length of each color section in the yarn.

## NOTES

1. If there is not enough of the contrastcolor section of the yarn to finish up the all the rows for the Leaf, end after any right side row, make sure you have at least 70" ( 178 cm ) of yarn remaining, and work the last row of the Leaf.
2. If there is not enough of the maincolor section of the yarn to finish up the all the rows for the Stripe, end after any wrong side row, make sure you have at least 150 " ( 381 cm ) of yarn remaining, and work the last 2 rows of the Stripe.

## SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

W\&T (wrap and turn) = Bring yarn to front, slip next st, turn, wrap yarn around slipped st and slip same st back onto right hand needle. On next row, work wrapped st by picking up the wrap and working it together with the wrapped st.

## SHAWL

Starting with the main color of the yarn, cast on 120 sts.
Work 10 rows in Garter st (k every row).


Row 4: K56, W\&T. Row 5: K52, W\&T. Row 6: K48, W\&T. Row 7: K44, W\&T. Row 8: K40, W\&T. Row 9: K36, W\&T. Row 10: K33, W\&T. Row 11: K30, W\&T. Row 12: K27, W\&T Row 13: K24, W\&T. Row 14: K21, W\&T Row 15: K18, W\&T Row 16: K15, W\&T. Row 17: K12, W\&T. Row 18: K9, W\&T.

## LEAF

Change to next contrast-color section of the yarn and work Leaf as follows (please read also pattern notes):

## Dec Section

Row 1 (right side): K2tog, $k$ to end -119 sts.
Row 2: K64, W\&T
Row 3: K60, W\&T.

## Inc Section

Row 1 (right side): Slip 1 knitwise, k11,
urn
Row 2: K15, turn.
Row 3: Slip 1 knitwise, k17, turn.
Row 4: K21, turn.
Row 5: Slip 1 knitwise, k23, turn.
Row 6: K27, turn.
Row 7: Slip 1 knitwise, k29, turn.
Row 8: K33, turn.
Row 9: Slip 1 knitwise, k35, turn.
Row 10: K40, turn.
Row 11: Slip 1 knitwise, k43, turn.
Row 12: K48, turn.
Row 13: Slip 1 knitwise, k51, turn.
Row 14: K56, turn.
Row 15: Slip 1 knitwise, k59, turn
Row 16: K60, turn
Row 17: K to end of row, turn.
Row 18: K to last 2 sts, k2tog - 118 sts.

## STRIPE

Change to next main-color section of the yarn and work Stripe as follows (please read also pattern notes):
Row 1 (right side): K2tog, $k$ to end - 117 sts.
Row 2: Bind off 12 sts, $k$ to last 2 sts, k2tog - 104 sts.
Row 3: K2tog, k to end - 103 sts.
Row 4: K3, W\&T.
Row 5: K3.
Row 6: K6, W\&T.
Row 7: K6.
Row 8: K9, W\&T.
Row 9: K9.
Row 10: K12, W\&T.
Row 11: K12.
Row 12: K15, W\&T.
Row 13: K15.
Row 14: K60, W\&T.
Row 15: K6, W\&T.
Row 16: K12, W\&T.

Row 17: K15, W\&T.
Row 18: K21, W\&T.
Row 19: K24, W\&T.
Row 20: K30, W\&T.
Row 21: K33, W\&T.
Row 22: K39, W\&T
Row 23: K42, W\&T
Row 24: K48, W\&T.
Row 25: K51, W\&T.
Row 26: $K$ to last 2 sts, k2tog - 103 sts Row 27: K2tog, $k$ to end- 102 sts.
Repeat Row 26 and 27 until there are about 150" ( 381 cm ) of the main color remaining.
Count the number of sts on last row.
Next Row (right side): $K$ to end, then cast on amount of sts to end up with 120 sts.
Next Row (wrong side): K to last 2 sts, k2tog - 119 sts.

Continue to alternate Leaf and Stripe sections until the last contrast-color section has been worked, ending after a wrong side row.

Change to the last main-color section and work 6 rows in Garter st.
Bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

With right side facing and using the main color of the yarn, join yarn in top right corner and work evenly in single crochet across neck edge.
Fasten off.
Weave in all loose ends

$\mathbf{d e c}=$ decrease; inc $=$ increase; $\mathbf{k}=$ knit;
k2tog = knit next 2 sts together; st(s) = stitch(es); * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ${ }^{* *}$ as indicated.
