What you will need:

RED HEART® Unforgettable Waves™: 4 balls 3931 Parade

Susan Bates* Circular Knitting Needles: 5.5mm [US 9] 29" long, yarn needle, stitch markers

GAUGE: 15 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Welt Pattern Stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Vibrant Knit Shawlette

This thick-and-thin yarn gives you a freespirited wrap that brightens your look and your outlook. Start at the center top, knit down to the point with the welt pattern stitch and finish off with a pretty edge. **Shawlette Finished Measurements:**

Welt Pattern Stitch (over any

PATTERN STITCH

number of stitches)

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit all stitches. Row 2 (Wrong Side): Purl all stitches. Row 3 (Right Side): Knit all stitches Row 4 (Wrong Side): Knit all stitches. Row 5 (Right Side): Knit all stitches. Repeat Rows 1--5 for Welt Pattern stitch.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Knitted Cast On Technique = Place slip knot on left needle; knit into slip knot, leaving the original stitch on the left needle. Also place the new stitch onto left needle, by slipping it knit-wise.*Knit into gap between last two stitches on left needle; leave the stitch on the left hand needle and slip the stitch just made to the left hand needle—1 stitch has been cast on; repeat from * to desired number of stitches.

K2tog = Knit 2 stitches together. **YO =** Yarn over.

SHAWLETTE

Cast on 5 stitches. Working in Welt Pattern Stitch throughout, begin working as follows:

Row 1 (Right Side): *K1, yo; repeat from * 4 times to last stitch, k1—9 sts.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): K1, purl to last stitch, k1.

Rows 3 (Right Side): K1, yo, k3, yo, place stitch marker, k1, place marker, yo, k3, yo, k1—13 sts.

Row 4 (Wrong Side): Knit all stitches—13 sts.

Row 5 (Right Side): K1, yo, knit to stitch marker, yo, slip marker, k1 center stitch, slip marker, yo, knit to last stitch, yo, k1 - 4 stitches increased—17 sts.

Continue working in Welt Pattern Stitch as established and repeating Row 5 every Right Side Row so that 4 stitches are increased every Right Side Row. Work until there are 126 stitches on either side of the center stitch and 253 stitches total. End having just completed Row 1 on the Right Side.

Next Row (Wrong Side) Eyelet Row:

K2, *yo, k2tog* repeat from * to * to stitch marker, slip marker, k1 center stitch, slip marker, *k2tog, yo*, repeat from * to* to last 2 stitches, k2.

Next Row (Right Side): Knit.

Next Row (Wrong Side) Picot Bind Off
Row: *Cast on 2 stitches on to the Left-

Hand needle using the Knitted Cast On Technique, bind off 5 stitches; repeat from * until all stitches have been bound off.

FINISHING

Using yarn needle, weave in ends. Block to measurements.
