What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Soft ${ }^{\circ}: 2$ balls each 9010 Charcoal A and 9518 Teal C; 1 ball 9925 Really Red B

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circ}$ Circular Knitting
Needles: 5.5 mm [US 9] 24" ( 61 cm ) and $36^{\prime \prime}(91 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

Stitch markers, Yarn needle
GAUGE: $17 \mathrm{sts}=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm}) ; 36$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in Garter st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge. RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Soft ${ }^{\circ}$, Art. E728, available in solid color $5 \mathrm{oz}(141 \mathrm{~g})$, $256 \mathrm{yd}(234 \mathrm{~m})$ and print 4 oz ( 113 g ), 204 yd ( 187 m ) balls

## Marly's Striped Knit Shawl

Start at the center top and knit your way down to the point. As you go you will be changing stitches and colors and creating the perfect striped shawl. Choose any three shades of yarn to tailor the colors to your own look and style.

Shawl measures $\mathbf{7 3 "}$ ( 185 cm ) across top and 20" ( 51 cm ) in depth

## SPECIAL STITCHES

$\mathbf{k f b}$ (Knit into front and back) $=$ Knit next st but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same st and remove from needle.

## Shawl

Setup
With A and shorter needles, cast on 4.
Row 1 (wrong side): K1, kfb, kfb, k1-6 sts. Row 2: K1, kfb, place marker, k1, place marker, k3-7 sts.

Place a removable marker to this side of the shawl to signify the right side.
Row 3: K1, kfb, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker, kfb, kfb, k1-11 sts.

## GARTER STITCH SECTION

Row 1 (right side): K1, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1-13 sts.
Row 2: Repeat Row 1-15 sts.
Row 3: $\mathrm{K} 1, \mathrm{kfb}$, knit to 1 st before marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 - 19 sts
Row 4: Repeat Row 1-21 sts.
Repeat the last 4 rows 3 more times -51 sts.
With B repeat Rows 1 and 2 - 55 sts.
With C repeat Rows 3 and 4 once, Rows 1-4 4 times, then Rows 1 and 2 once - 105 sts.
With B repeat rows 3 and 4 once -111 sts.
With A repeat rows $1-44$ times -151 sts.
With B repeat rows 1 and 2 once -155 sts.

## STRIPES SECTION

Note: Begin with shorter needles switching to longer needles as stitches increase.

* Row 1 (right side): With C, k1, kfb, knit to 1 st before marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 159 sts.

Row 2: K1, kfb, purl to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 161 sts.
Rows 3 and 4: With A, K1, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 - 165 sts.
Repeat the last 4 rows 3 more times, then rows 1 and 2 only once more - 201 sts.
With B, repeat rows 3 and $4-205$ sts.
Repeat from ** twice more - 305 sts.

## SEED STITCH SECTION

Row 1 (right side): With C, ( $\mathrm{K} 1, \mathrm{p} 1$ ) in first st, k1, * p1, k1; repeat from * to marker, [sm k1] twice, ${ }^{* *}$ p1, k1; repeat from ** to last st, ( $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ ) in last st - 307 sts.
Row 2: (P1, k1) in first st, * p1, k1; repeat from * to marker, [sm, k1] twice, p1, ** k1, p 1 ; repeat from ** to last st, (k1, p1) in last st - 309 sts.
Row 3: (K1, p1) in first st, * k1, p1; repeat from * to last st before marker, (k1, p1) in next st, slip marker, k1, slip marker, (p1, k1) in next st, ** p1, k1; repeat from ** to last st, ( $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ ) in last st -313 sts.
Row 4: (P1, k1) in first st, p1, * k1, p1; repeat from * to marker, slip marker, k1, slip marker, p1 ${ }^{* *} \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1$; repeat from ${ }^{* *}$ to last st, (k1, p1) in last st - 315 sts.
Row 5: (K1, p1) in first st, * k1, p1; repeat from * to marker, slip marker, k1, slip marker, ** p1, k1; repeat from ** to last st, (p1, k1) in last st - 317 sts.
Row 6: (P1, k1) in first st, p1, * k1, p1; repeat from * to marker, slip marker, k1, slip marker, p1, ** k1, p1; repeat from ** to last st, (k1, p1) in last st - 319 sts.

Continued...


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Row 7: (K1, p1) in first st, k1, * p1, k1; repeat from * to last st before marker, (p1, k1) in next st, slip marker, k1, slip marker, (k1, p1) in next st, k1, ${ }^{* *} \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$; repeat from ${ }^{* *}$ to last st, (p1, k1) in last st - 323 sts.
Row 8: ( $\mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ ) in first st, * p 1 , k 1 ; repeat
from * to marker, slip marker, k1, slip marker,
${ }^{* *} \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1$; repeat from ** to last st, (k1, p1) in last st - 325 sts.
Repeat the last 8 rows once more, then Rows 1 and 2 only once more - 349 sts. With B, repeat Rows 3 and 4-355 sts. Do not bind off.

## APPLIED I-CORD

With B, cast on 4 more sts on left hand needle.
Next Row: K3, k2tog, then slip the 4 sts just made to the left hand needle. Repeat this row until 4 total sts remain. Cut yarn and use yarn needle to weave tail through all open sts.
Pull tight.

## FINISHING

Weave in all loose ends.
