What you will need:

RED HEART® Heart & Sole®:
2 balls 3800 Blue **A**, 1 ball each of
3900 Fuchsia **B**, and 3931
Victorian **C**

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:
3.75mm [US 5]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 19 sts = 4" (10cm); 40
rows = 4" (10cm) in Garter stitch
(knit every row). **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE. Use any size needles to
obtain the gauge.**



**RED HEART® Heart

available in solid color
and multicolor 1.76 oz
(50 g), 187 yd (171 m)

Modern Stripe Shawl

*This triangular shawl features an
off-center point and modern garter stitch style.
Knit it in three shades of lightweight sock yarn for
maximum drape-ability.*

SHOP KIT

**Shawl measures 60" (152.5cm) across top
(longest) edge x 20" (51cm) from center
back to off-center lower point.**

Notes

1. Shawl is worked in one piece beginning at one front point.
2. Increases are worked at the end of wrong side rows to shape shawl. The diagonal edge formed by the end of wrong side rows is the top edge of the Shawl.

Special Stitch

kfb (Knit into front and back) = Knit next stitch but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same stitch and remove from needle.

SHAWL

With **A**, cast on 1 st.

First Solid Section

Row 1 (wrong side): Kfb—2 sts.

Row 2: Kfb, k1—3 sts.

Row 3: K2, kfb—4 sts.

Row 4 (right side): K2, yo, knit to end of row—5 sts.

Row 5: Knit to last st, kfb—6 sts.

Row 6: K2, yo, knit to end of row—7 sts.

Row 7: K1, k2tog, knit to last st, kfb.

Repeat Rows 4–7 for 36 more times—115 sts.

First Striped Section

Change to **B**. Do not cut **A**. Carry color not in use carefully up side edge when next needed.

Repeat Rows 4–7 for 21 more times, changing color every other row to alternate 2 rows worked with **B** and 2 rows worked with **A**—178 sts.

Second Solid Section

Cut **A**. Work with **B** only.

Repeat Rows 4–7 for 3 more times—187 sts.

Repeat Rows 4 and 5 once more—189 sts.

Second Striped Section

Change to **C**. Do not cut **B**. Carry color not in use carefully up side edge when next needed.

With **C**, repeat Rows 6 and 7—190 sts.

Repeat Rows 4–7 for 3 more times, changing color every other row to alternate 2 rows worked with **B** and 2 rows worked with **C**—199 sts.

Eyelet Section

Cut **B**. Work with **C** only.

Row 1 (right side): K2, *yo, k2tog; repeat from * to last st, yo, k1—200 sts.

Row 2: Knit to last st, kfb—201 sts.

Row 3: K2, yo, knit to end of row—202 sts.

Row 4: K1, k2tog, knit to last st, kfb.

Row 5: K2, *yo, k2tog; repeat from * to last 2 sts, yo, k2—203 sts.

Row 6: Knit to last st, kfb—204 sts.

Row 7: K2, yo, knit to end of row—205 sts.

Row 8: K1, k2tog, knit to last st, kfb.

Repeat Rows 1–8 for 2 more times—217 sts.

Repeat Rows 1–4 once more—220 sts.

Bind off.

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FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to size.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit; **k2tog** = knit next 2 sts together;
st(s) = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; * = repeat
whatever follows the * as indicated.
