## What you will need:

RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ With Love ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Metallic: 3 balls 8303 Aran

Susan Bates ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Circular Knitting Needles: 5.5 mm [US 9] 32" ( 81.25 cm ) or longer

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 12 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$; 24 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in St st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge given. Art. E400BM available in solid 4.5 oz (127 g) 200 yds ( 183 m ), prints 4 oz ( 113 g ) 152 yd ( 139 m ) balls


## Winter Trellis Shawl

Keep warm and sparkly with this pretty knit shawl. Each section is a different stitch pattern, keeping things interesting as it grows on your needles.

Shawl measures 72" ( 183 cm ) across widest point $\times 30^{\prime \prime}(76 \mathrm{~cm})$ at longest center point.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

k1tbl (knit 1 through the back loop):
Insert the right needle into the back loop of the stitch from front to back, then knit the stitch.
$\mathbf{k f b}$ : knit into the front and back of the same stitch - 1 stitch increased.
P1tbl (purl 1 through the back loop):
Insert the right needle into the back loop of the stitch from back to front, then purl the stitch.
psso: pass the slipped stitch over - 1 stitch decreased.
NOTE
When working St st, maintain the Garter st edge by knitting the first and last 2 sts of each row.

## SHAWL

Cast on 5 sts.
Section 1
Row 1 (Right Side): Knit across
Row 2 (Wrong Side): K2, yo, k1, yo, k2 7 sts.
Row 3: K2, k1tbl, k1, k1tbl, k2.
Row 4: K2, *yo, k1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2-10 sts.
Row 5: K2, *k1, k1tbl; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 6: Knit across.

## Section 2

Row 7: K2, *yo, k1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2-16 sts.
Row 8: K2, *k1, k1tbl; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 9: Knit across.
Row 10: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2. Row 11: Knit across.

## Section 3

Row 12: K2, *yo, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2-28 sts
Row 13: K2, *p1, p1tbl; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 14: K2, *k1, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 15: K2, *p1, k1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Rows 16-17: Repeat Rows 14-15
Rows 18-19: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2.

## Section 4

Row 20: K2, *yo, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2-52 sts.
Row 21: K2, *k1, k1tbl; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Rows 22-24: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 25: K2, *slip 1, k2, psso; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2 - 36 sts.

Row 26: K2, p1, *yo, p2; repeat from * to last 3 sts, yo, p1, k2 - 52 sts.
Row 27: Knit across.
Row 28: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2. Row 29: K3, *sl1, k2, psso; repeat from * to last 4 sts, k4-37 sts.
Row 30: K2, p3, *yo, p2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2 - 52 sts.
Row 31: Knit across.
Row 32: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2.
Rows 33-34: Repeat Rows 25-26.
Row 35: Knit across.
Row 36: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2.

## Section 5

Row 37: K2, *yo, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2-100 sts.
Row 38: K2, *p1, p1tbl; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2
Row 39: Knit across.
Row 40: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2. Rows 41-42: Knit across
continued..


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Row 43: K2, *k1, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 44: K2, *p1, k1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Rows 45-50: Repeat Rows 43-44
Rows 51-52: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2.
Rows 53-59: Work in St st (knit right side rows and purl wrong side rows), maintaining the Garter st edge on the first and last 2 sts of each row.
Row 60: Knit across.
Row 61: K2, *slip 1, k2, psso; repeat from
to last 2 sts, k2 - 68 sts
Row 62: K2, p1, *yo, p2; repeat from * to last 3 sts, yo, p1, k2-100 sts.
Row 63: Knit across.
Row 64: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2. Row 65: K3, *s11, k2, psso; repeat from * to last 4 sts, k4-69 sts.
Row 66: K2, p3, *yo, p2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2-100 sts.
Row 67: Knit across.
Row 68: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2.

## Section 6

Row 69: K2, *yo, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2-196 sts.
Row 70: K2, *p1, p1tbl; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k 2.
Rows 71-73: Work in St st.
Row 74: Knit across.
Row 75: K2, *p1, k1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 76: K2, *k1, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Rows 77-78: Repeat Rows 75-76.
Rows 79-80: K2, purl across to last 2
sts, k2.
Rows 81-83: Work in St st
Row 84: Knit across.
Row 85: K2, *sl1, k2, psso; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2-132 sts.
Row 86: K2, *p1, yo, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2-196 sts.

Rows 87-88: Work in St st
Row 89: K3, *s11, k2, psso; repeat from * to last 4 sts, k4-133 sts.
Row 90: K2, p3, *yo, p2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2 - 196 sts.
Rows 91-92: Work in St st.
Row 93: K4, *sl1, k2, psso; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k3-133 sts.
Row 94: K2, *p2, yo; repeat from * to
last 5 sts, p3, k2-196 sts.
Rows 95-96: Work in St st.
Rows 97-98: Repeat Rows 85-86.
Rows 99-100: Work in St st.
Row 101: K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2.
Rows 102-105: Work in St st.
Row 106: Knit across.
Row 107: K2, *k1, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 108: K2, *p1, k1; repeat from * to
last 2 sts, k2.
Rows 109-116: Repeat Rows 107-108.

Row 117: Repeat Row 107
Row 118: Knit across.
Rows 119-122: Work in St st.
Rows 123-124: K2, purl across to last 2
sts, k2.
Rows 125-126: Repeat Rows 85-86
Rows 127-128: Work in St st.
Rows 129-130: Repeat Rows 89-90.
Row 131-132: Work in St st.
Row 133: K2, *slip 1, k2, psso; repeat
from * to last 2 sts, k2 - 132 sts.
Row 134: K2, p1, *yo, p2; repeat from *
to last 3 sts, yo, p1, k2-196 sts.
Rows 135-136: Work in St st.
Rows 137-138: Repeat Rows 85-86.
Rows 139-140: Work in St st.
Rows 141-142: Repeat Rows 89-90
Rows 143-144: Knit across.
Rows 145-150: Work in Garter st (knit every row).
Bind off all sts loosely.

## FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in all loose ends.

$\mathbf{K}=$ knit; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{P}=$ Purl; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; yo = yarn over; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
