What you will need:

RED HEART® Fashion Soft™:

1 ball each Flax 4200 **A**,
Bright Pink 4702 **B**, and
Camel 4613 **C**

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting

Needles: 4.5mm [US 7], 32"
(81 cm) or longer

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 18 sts = 4" [10 cm];
36 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter
st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use
any size needles to obtain the
gauge given.

Spring Ribbons Shawl

The slip stitch design is easy to memorize,
making this shawl a project that packs a lot
of style into one pattern! The subtle shaping
also helps keep it on your shoulders.

**Shawl measures 60" (152 cm) at widest
point x 22" (56 cm) long.**

SPECIAL STITCH

Wrapping Yarn: When the instructions
say to purl wrapping yarn around needle
twice, insert the right needle into the
next stitch on the left needle as if to
purl, wrap the yarn twice around the
right needle, and then purl the stitch.
When you work to these wrapped
stitches on the next row, drop the wraps
to elongate the stitch.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Kfb: Knit into front then back of same
stitch – 1 stitch increased.

Kfbf: Knit into front, then back, then
front again of same stitch – 2 stitches
increased.

SHAWL

With **A** and using long-tail cast on, cast
on 3 sts.

Rows 1-10: Knit.

Turn work 90 degrees clockwise; pick up
and knit 5 sts along edge (1 st for each
garter ridge); turn work 90 degrees
clockwise again and pick up 3 sts along
original cast on edge – 11 sts.

Segment 1

Rows 1-3: Knit.

Row 4 (Inc): Kfbf, [kfb] 4 times, kfbf,
[kfb] 4 times, kfbf – 24 sts.

Segment 2

Rows 1-7: Knit.

Row 8 (Inc): Kfb in each st across –
48 sts.

Segment 3

Rows 1-15: Knit.

Row 16 (Inc): Kfb in each st across –
96 sts.

Segment 4

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2 (Inc): [K9, kfb] 9 times, knit to
end – 105 sts.

Slip-Stitch Blocks

Cut **A**. Join **B**.

Rows 1 & 3 (Right Side): Knit.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Row 4: P3, P3 wrapping yarn around
needle twice, *p9, p3 wrapping yarn
around needle twice; repeat from * to
last 3 sts, p3.

Join **C**, but do not cut **B**. Carry **B** along
the side of your work while working
rows in **C**.

Rows 5 & 7: With **C**, k3, slip 3 purlwise,
*k9, slip 3 purlwise; repeat from * to last
3 sts, k3.

Rows 6 & 8: With **C**, k3, bring yarn to
front of work, slip 3 purlwise, *bring
yarn to back of work, k9, bring yarn to
front of work, slip 3 purlwise; repeat
from * to last 3 sts, bring yarn to back of
work, k3.

Cut **C**.

Rows 9 & 11 (Right Side): With **B**, knit.

Row 10 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Row 12: *P9, p3 wrapping yarn around
needle twice; repeat from * to last
9 sts, p9.

Join **A**, but do not cut **B**.

Rows 13 & 15: With **A**, *k9, slip 3
purlwise; repeat from * to last 9 sts, k9.

Rows 14 & 16: With **A**, *k9, bring yarn to
front of work, slip 3 purlwise, bring yarn
to back of work; repeat from * to last
9 sts, k9.

Cut **A**.

Rows 17-24: Repeat Rows 1-8.

Rows 25 & 27: With **B**, knit.

Rows 26 & 28: Purl.

Cut **B** and join **C**.

Rows 29 & 30: With **C**, knit.

Inc Row: Kfb in each st across – 210 sts.

Segment 5

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2 (Inc): K8, kfb, [K23, kfb] 8 times, K9 – 219 sts.

Rows 3 – 30: Knit.

Slip-Stitch Blocks

Cut **C**. Join **B**.

Rows 1 & 3 (Right Side): Knit.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Row 4: P3, p3 wrapping yarn around needle twice, *p9, p3 wrapping yarn around needle twice; repeat from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Join **A**, but do not cut **B**. Carry **B** along the side of your work while working rows in **A**.

Rows 5 & 7: With **A**, k3, slip 3 purlwise, *k9, slip 3 purlwise; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Rows 6 & 8: With **A**, k3, bring yarn to front of work, slip 3 purlwise, *bring yarn to back of work, k9, bring yarn to front of work, slip 3 purlwise; repeat from * to last 3 sts, bring yarn to back of work, k3.

Cut **A**.

Rows 9 & 11 (Right Side): With **B**, knit.

Row 10 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Row 12: *P9, p3 wrapping yarn around needle twice; repeat from * to last 9 sts, p9.

Join **C**, but do not cut **B**.

Rows 13 & 15: With **C**, *k9, slip 3 purlwise; repeat from * to last 9 sts, k9.

Rows 14 & 16: With **C**, *k9, bring yarn to front of work, slip 3 purlwise, bring yarn to back of work; repeat from * to last 9 sts, k9.

Cut **C**.

Rows 17-24: Repeat Rows 1-8.

Rows 25 & 27: With **B**, knit.

Rows 26 & 28: With **B**, purl.

Cut **B** and join **A**.

Rows 29 & 30: With **A**, knit.

Row 31 (Inc): Kfb to end of row – 438 sts.

Segment 6

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2 (Inc): Knit, inc 3 sts evenly spaced using kfb – 441 sts.

Rows 3 – 30: Knit.

Slip-Stitch Blocks

Cut **A**. Join **B**.

Rows 1 & 3 (Right Side): Knit.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Row 4: P3, p3 wrapping yarn around needle twice, *p9, p3 wrapping yarn around needle twice; repeat from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Join **C**, but do not cut **B**. Carry **B** along the side of your work while working rows in **C**.

Rows 5 & 7: With **C**, k3, slip 3 purlwise, *k9, slip 3 purlwise; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Rows 6 & 8: Using **C**, k3, bring yarn to front of work, slip 3 purlwise, *bring yarn to back of work, k9, bring yarn to front of work, slip 3 purlwise; repeat from * to last 3 sts, bring yarn to back of work, k3.

Cut **C**.

Rows 9 & 11 (Right Side): With **B**, knit.

Row 10 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Row 12: *P9, P3 wrapping yarn around needle twice; repeat from * to last 9 sts, p9.



Join **A**, but do not cut **B**.

Rows 13 & 15: With **A**, *k9, slip 3 purlwise; repeat from * to last 9 sts, k9.

Rows 14 & 16: With **A**, *k9, bring yarn to front of work, slip 3 purlwise, bring yarn to back of work; repeat from * to last 9 sts, k9.

Cut **A**.

Rows 17-24: Repeat Rows 1-8.

Rows 25 & 27: With **B**, knit.

Rows 26 & 28: Purl.

Edging

Row 1: With **C**, knit.

Row 2: With **B**, knit.

Cut **B**.

With **C**, bind off.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in loose ends. Wet block to measurements.

A = Color A; **B** = Color B; **C** = Color C;
inc = increase(s)(d)(ing); **K** = knit; **mm**
= millimeters; **P** = Purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es);
[] = work directions in brackets the
number of times specified; * = rep
