What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\otimes}$ Hygge $^{\text {TM }}$ : 2 balls 8406 Pearl

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Circular Knitting Needles: 6.5 mm [US 10½] 36" ( 91.5 cm )

Stitch markers
Yarn needle
GAUGE: 12 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm}) 18$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in St st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge

## Winter Wonder Shawl

Hygge yarn and this shawl are a perfect, snuggly combination! The bobbles add even more gentle texture to this already soft yarn, you'll love it!

Shawl measures 52" wide x $15^{\prime \prime}$ long [132 x 38 cm ]

## NOTES

1. To avoid the long edge from becoming too tight or puckering, work a yarnover (yo) after the first stitch on the wrong side rows, then drop that yo when you come to it on the right side.
2. Slip markers as you come to them.
3. Shawl is worked back and forth in rows. A circular needle is used in order to accommodate the full width of the stitches.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

kfbf (Knit into the front and then back and then front) $=$ Knit the next stitch on the left hand needle and before taking it off the needle, insert the tip of your working needle into the backside of the same stitch and knit it through the back loop; then insert the tip of your working needle into the front of the same stitch and knit it through the front loop. Transfer the 3 stitches to the right hand needle - 2 st increased.
kfb (Knit into front and back) = Knit next st but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same st and remove from needle. BACK
Bobble $=$ Knit into the front and back of the stitch twice; turn and purl the 4 sts; turn and knit the 4 sts; bind off 3 of the 4 sts by slipping the second st over the first 3 times to return the count to one.

## SHAWL

## Set Up

Cast on 3 sts
Row 1 (right side): Kfb, k1, kfb - 5 sts.
Row 2: K2, place marker, p1, place marker, k2.
Row 3: K2, slip marker, kfbf, slip marker, k2-7 sts.
Row 4: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2.


## Section 1

Row 5 (right side): K2, slip marker, k2tog, knit until 3 sts remain, kfbf, slip marker, k2-1 st increased.
Row 6: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2
Rows 7-22: Repeat Rows 5-6, 8 times 16 sts.

## Section 2 Eyelet

Row 23 (right side): Repeat Row 5-17 sts.
Row 24: Knit.
Row 25: Repeat Row 5-18 sts.
Row 26: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2

continued...



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Row 27: K2, slip marker, k2tog, *ssk, yo, k1; repeat from * until 5 sts remain, ssk, yo, kfbf, slip marker, k2-19 sts.
Row 28: K2, slip marker, purl to marker working each yo as a purl stitch, slip marker, k2.
Row 29: Repeat Row 5-20 sts.
Row 30: Knit.
Rows 31-52: Repeat Rows 5-6, 11 times - 31 sts.

## Section 3 Bobble

Row 53 (right side): Repeat Row 5-32 sts.

## Row 54: Knit.

Row 55: Repeat Row 5-33 sts.
Row 56: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2.
Row 57: K2, slip marker, k2tog, k1,
*make bobble, k3; repeat from * until 4 sts remain, make bobble, kfbf, slip marker, k2-34 sts.
Row 58: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2.
Row 59: Repeat Row 5 - 35 sts.
Row 60: Knit.
Rows 61-90: Repeat Rows 5-6, 15 times - 50 sts.

## Section 4 Eyelet

Row 91 (right side): Repeat Row 5-51 sts.
Row 92: Knit.
Row 93: Repeat Row 5 - 52 sts.
Row 94: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2.
Row 95: K2, slip marker, k2tog, k1, *ssk, yo, k1; repeat from * until 5 sts remain, ssk, yo, kfbf, slip marker, k2-53 sts.
Row 96: K2, slip marker, purl to marker working each yo as a purl stitch, slip marker, k2.
Row 97: Repeat Row 5 - 54 sts.
Row 98: Knit.

## Section 5

Row 99 (right side): K2, slip marker, knit until 3 sts remain, kfbf, slip marker, k2 2 sts increased.
Row 100: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2.
Row 101: Repeat Row 5-1 st increased.
Row 102: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2.

Rows 103-138: Repeat Rows 99-102, 9 times - 84 sts.

## Section 6 Bobble

Row 139 (right side): K2, slip marker, knit until 3 sts remain, kfbf, slip marker, k2-86 sts.
Row 140: Knit.
Row 141: Repeat Row 5-87 sts.
Row 142: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2.
Row 143: K2, slip marker, k2tog, k3,
*make bobble, k3; repeat from * until 4 sts remain, make bobble, kfbf, slip marker, k2-88 sts.
Row 144: K2, slip marker, purl to second marker, slip marker, k2.
Row 145: Repeat Row 5-89 sts. Row 146: Knit.

## FINISHING

Row 147 (right side): K2, slip marker, k2tog, knit until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip marker, k2.

Bind off knitwise
Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeters; $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{k f b}=$ knit into the front and then back of the same stitch ( 1 st increased); kfbf = knit into the front, then back, then front of the same stitch ( 2 sts increased); $\mathbf{k 2 t o g}=$ knit 2 stitches together; mm = millimeters; M1L = make 1 left; $\mathbf{M 1 R}=$ make 1 right; ssk = slip, slip knit; st(s) = stitch(es); yo = yarn over needle; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
