What you will need:

RED HEART® Hygge™: 5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7) balls 8339 Cloud

Susan Bates® Knitting **Needles:** 6.5 mm [US 10½]

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needles: 6.5 mm [US 101/2] 16" (40.5 cm)

Stitch holder, yarn needle

GAUGE: 13 sts and 18 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette St (knit on right side, purl on wrong side). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles/hook to obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT



So Soft Comfy Sweater

Not only will you love knitting with this bulky weight yarn, you will enjoy wearing the luxurious short furry texture of this soft Hygge varn. We offer this pattern in a comfy, classic style that you will wear for years to come.

Directions are for size S; changes for sizes M, L, XL, 2X, and 3X are in parentheses.

Sweater measures 37½ (41, 45, 48½, 52½, 56)" (95.5 (104, 114.5, 123, 133.5, 142) cm) around bust and 23½ (24, 24½, 25, 25½, 26)" (59.5 (61, 62, 63.5, 65, 66) cm) in length.

SPECIAL STITCHES

M1 (make 1 increase) = Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and work strand through the back loop. twisting it to prevent a hole, and knit it. Ssk (slip, slip, knit) = Slip next two sts knitwise to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

3 x 3 RIB

Worked over a multiple of 6 sts + 3. Row 1 (right side): * K3, p3; repeat from * to last 3 sts. k3.

Row 2: * P3, k3; repeat from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 for 3 x 3 Rib.

BACK

Cast on 63 (69, 75, 81, 87, 93) sts, and work in 3 x 3 Rib for 14 rows. Change to Stockinette st and work evenly until piece measures 17" (43 cm).

Shape Armholes

Bind off 4 sts at beginning of the next 2 rows - 55 (61, 67, 73, 79, 85) sts. Work evenly in Stockinette St until armhole measures 6½ (7, 7½, 8, 8½, 9)" (16.5 (18, 19, 20.5, 21.5, 23) cm). Bind off all sts.

FRONT

Work same as Back until armholes measure 3" (7.5 cm), ending after a wrong side (purl) row.



Separate for Neck and Shoulders Next row (right side): K17 (20, 22, 25, 27, 30), place center 21 (21, 23, 23, 25, 25) sts on holder, join new yarn and k17 (20, 22, 25, 27, 30).

Right Shoulder

Work across 17 (20, 22, 25, 27, 30) Right Shoulder sts only as follows:

Row 1 (wrong side): Purl.

Row 2 (dec row, right side): K1, ssk, knit to end - 16 (19, 21, 24, 26, 29) sts. Repeat the last 2 rows 4 more times - 12 (15, 17, 20, 22, 25) sts.

Work evenly in Stockinette St until armhole measures 6½ (7, 7½, 8, 8½, 9)" (16.5 (18, 19, 20.5, 21.5, 23) cm). Bind off all sts.

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Left Shoulder

Work across remaining 17 (20, 22, 25, 27, 30) Left Shoulder sts as follows:

Row 1 (wrong side): Purl.

Row 2 (dec row, right side): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 16 (19, 21, 24, 26, 29) sts.

Repeat the last 2 rows 4 more times – 12 (15, 17, 20, 22, 25) sts.

Work evenly in Stockinette St until armholo measures 616 (7, 716, 8, 816, 9)"

armhole measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ (7, $7\frac{1}{2}$, 8, $8\frac{1}{2}$, 9)" (16.5 (18, 19, 20.5, 21.5, 23) cm). Bind off all sts.

SLEEVES

Cast on 29 (29, 29, 35, 35, 35) sts. **Row 1 (right side):** K4, * p3, k3; repeat from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: P4, * k3, p3; repeat from * to last st, p1.

Repeat the last 2 rows 6 more times. Work 8 (6, 6, 6, 4, 4) rows in Stockinette st, beginning with a right side (knit) row and ending after a wrong side (purl) row.

Next row (inc row, right side): K2, M1, knit to last 2 sts, M1, k2 - 31 (31, 31, 37, 37, 37) sts.

Repeat this increase every 8 (6, 6, 6, 4, 4) rows 4 (3, 7, 4, 2, 8) more times, then every 10 (8, 8, 8, 6, 6) rows 2 (5, 2, 4, 8, 4) more times – 43 (47, 49, 53, 57, 61) sts.

Work evenly in Stockinette St until sleeve measures 18 (18, 17½, 17½, 17, 17)" (45.5 (45.5, 44.5, 44.5, 43, 43) cm). Bind off all sts.

Make other Sleeve the same.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew tops of Sleeves into armholes. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Neckband

With circular needle and right side facing, and beginning at left shoulder seam, pick up and k 15 (15, 18, 18, 21, 21) sts down left neck edge, k 21 (21, 23, 23, 25, 25) from Front neck holder, pick up and k 15 (15, 18, 18, 21, 21) sts up right neck edge, then pick up and k 27 (27, 31, 31, 35, 35) sts across Back neck edge – 78 (78, 90, 90, 102, 102) sts.

Join round and mark first st.

Round 1: * K3, p3; repeat from * to end.

Repeat this round until neckband measures 2½" (6.5 cm).

Bind off all sts loosely.

Weave in all loose ends.

dec = decrease; inc = increase; k = knit;
k2tog = knit next 2 sts together; p =
purl; st(s) = stitch(es); * or ** = repeat
