What you will need:

RED HEART® Mixology Solids: 2 (3, 3, 3, 4) balls 862 Royal **A** and 402 Grey **D**

RED HEART® Mixology Swirl: 4 (5, 6, 7, 7) balls 9956 Blue Suede B RED HEART® Mixology Prints: 2 (3, 3, 3, 3) balls 956 Blue Suede Print C

GAUGE: 7 sts = 4" (10 cm); 9 rows = 4" (10 cm), in Stockinette st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) with A. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Mixed Textures Pullover

Coordinating super bulky yarns are combined for a thoroughly modern take on the comfy sweater. The Mixology yarns can be mixed, matched and fashioned into a knit you'll love wearing.

What you will need continued:

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 10 mm

[US 15] 16" (40 cm) circular needle, set of double pointed needles (for sleeves), and one additional needle for 3 Needle Bind Off

Stitch holder, stitch marker, yarn needle.

Sweater directions are for size Small. Changes for sizes Medium, Large, X-Large, and XX-Large are in parentheses.

To Fit Bust: 34 (38, 42, 46, 50)" (86.5 (96.5,

106.5, 117, 127) cm)

Finished Bust: 38 (42, 46, 50, 54)" (96.5

(106.5, 117, 127, 137) cm)

Finished Length: 22 (23, 24, 25, 26)" (56 (58.5, 61, 63.5, 66) cm, from lower edge to

shoulder

Special Stitches

kfb (Knit into front and back) = Knit next st but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same st and remove from needle.

ssk = Slip next 2 stitches as if to knit to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

Notes

- 1. Back and front panels are made first.
- 2. Shoulders are seamed and then stitches are picked up across the side edges of the seamed piece to work side panels.
- 3. 3 Needle Bind Off is used to join side panels for side seams.
- 4. Sleeves are worked in rounds beginning over the remaining side panel stitches, above the side seams.

BACK PANEL

With circular needle and **A**, cast on 19 (21, 23, 25, 27) sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.

Row 1 (wrong side): With **A**, k1, *p1, k1; repeat from * to end of row.

Rows 2–4: Repeat Row 1 four more times. Cut **A**.

Rows 6–9: With **B**, beginning with a right side (knit) row, work in Stockinette st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) for 4 rows. Cut **B**.

Row 10 (right side): With C, knit.
Rows 11–19: With C, work in Reverse
Stockinette st (knit on wrong side, purl on right side) for 9 rows.

Cut C.

Row 20 (right side): With D, knit. Row 21: With D, p7, knit to last 7 sts, p7. Row 22: With D, k7, p to last 7 sts, k7. Rows 23 and 24: Repeat Rows 21 and 22. Cut D.

Repeat Rows 1–24 until piece measures about 22 (23, 24, 25, 26)" (56 (58.5, 61, 63.5, 66) cm) from beginning.

Bind off.

FRONT PANEL

Work same as back panel until piece measures about 19 (20, 21, 22, 23)" (48.5 (51, 53.5, 56, 58.5) cm) from beginning; ending with a wrong side row.

Shape Left Side of Neck

Row 1 (right side): Continue in pattern over first 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, place remaining 15 (16, 17, 18, 19) sts on a holder—4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts. Work over the remaining 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, continuing in the same pattern stitches and colors as back, until front measures same as back. Bind off.

Shape Right Side of Neck

Return the 15 (16, 17, 18, 19) sts from holder to knitting needle, ready to work a right side row.

Row 1 (right side): Join yarn and bind off first 11 sts (for neck), work in pattern over the remaining 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts.

Work over the remaining 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, continuing in the same pattern stitches and colors as back, until front measures same as back.

Bind off.

Sew back and front shoulder seams.

LEFT SIDE PANEL

Row 1 (right side): With right side facing, circular needle and **D**, beginning at lower edge of front, pick up and k38 (40, 42, 44, 45) sts evenly spaced across left side edge to shoulder, pick up and k1 st at shoulder seam, pick up and k38 (40, 42, 44, 45) sts evenly spaced across left side edge to lower edge of back—77 (81, 85, 89, 91) sts.

Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.

Row 2: With D, knit.

Cut **D**.

With **B**, work in Stockinette st until side panel measures about 4 (4½, 5, 5½, 6)" (10 (11.5, 12.5, 14, 15) cm).

Fold fabric in half so that the right sides of the halves are together and tips of needles point in the same direction.

3 Needle Bind Off

With3rd needle knit together first stitch from each needle, *knit together next stitch from each needle, pass first stitch over 2nd stitch and off right needle; repeat from * until 24 (25, 26, 27, 28) pairs of sts have been bound off and a total of 29 (31, 33, 35, 35) sts remain on needles for sleeve. Slip remaining stitch on straight needle back to circular needle.

Cut B.

LEFT SLEEVE

Round 1 (right side): From right side with circular needle and **D**, beginning at underarm, knit to end of round. Place marker for beginning of round—29 (31, 33, 35, 35) sts.

Rounds 2-5: Knit.

Round 6: K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1—27 (29, 31, 33, 33) sts.

Change to double pointed needles when stitches no longer fit comfortably on circular needle.

Rounds 7-11: Knit.

Round 12: Repeat Round 6—25 (27, 29, 31, 31) sts.

Repeat Rounds 7–12 for 3 (4, 4, 5, 5) more times—19 (19, 21, 21, 21) sts.

Next Round: Knit.

Repeat last round until sleeve measures about 18" (45.5 cm) or 2" (5 cm) less than desired length.

Cut **D**.

Next Round: With **C**, k1, k2tog, knit to end of round—18 (18, 20, 20, 20) sts.

Next Round: With **C**, *k1, p1; repeat from * to end of round.

Repeat last round for 2" (5 cm). Bind off.

RIGHT SIDE PANEL AND RIGHT SLEEVE

Work same as left side panel and left sleeve, beginning at lower edge of back.

FINISHING

Collar

With right side facing circular needle and **B**, pick up and k34 sts evenly spaced around neck edge. Place marker for beginning of round.

Increase Round: K2, *k1, kfb; repeat from * around—50 sts.

Next Round: *K1, p1; repeat from * around. Repeat last round until collar measures about 5" (12.5 cm).

Bind off.

Weave in ends. Soak piece, lay flat to dry.




k = knit; **k2tog** = knit next 2 sts together; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.


