





KNIT SKILL LEVEL **EASY**

What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Treasure™: 5 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8) balls 1919 Watercolors

Yarn Quantity Note: When adding a new ball, blend the colors by joining the next ball with the same color that just finished. Save the partial balls to combine. It is helpful to buy an extra ball of yarn.

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8]

Stitch markers, yarn needle.

Gauge: 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in 3×1 Ribbing. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Monet's Garden Sweater

The elegant lines of this classic ribbed sweater are updated by the subtle changes in color created by RED HEART®

Boutique Treasure™.

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium, Large, 1X, 2X and 3X are in parentheses.

Finished Measurements

Bust: 36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 56)", [91 (102, 112, 122, 132, 142) cm]

Length: 21 (22, 23, 24, 25, 26)", [53 (56, 58, 61, 64, 66) cm]

Note

Back and front are knit and joined at shoulders. Sleeves are picked up and knit down to cuff.

3 x 1 Ribbing (multiple of 4 + 1): Row 1 (Right Side): K1, * p3, k1; repeat from * across.

Row 2: P1, * k3, p1; repeat from * across. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for Ribbing.

SWEATER

Front and Back (Alike)

Cast on 73 (81, 89, 97, 105, 113) sts. Work in 3 x 1 Ribbing for 14 (14½, 15, 15½, 16, 16½)", [36 (37, 38, 39, 41, 42) cm] . Place markers at each edge for armhole placement. Continue in pattern until 21 (22, 23, 24, 25, 26)", [53 (56, 58, 61, 64, 66) cm from beginning. Bind off in pattern.

Sew shoulder seams, leaving center 8" [20 cm] open for neck.

Sleeves


With right side facing, pick up and K57 (61, 65, 69, 73, 77) sts between markers. Work in 3 x 1 Ribbing, begin Row 2 and shape sides by decreasing 1 st at each edge every 8 (6, 6, 6, 4, 4)th row 9 (6, 8, 6, 18, 18) times, and then every 6th (6th, 4th, 4th, 2nd) row 5 (10, 10, 12, 2, 2) times - 29 (29, 29, 33, 33, 37) sts. Work even until sleeve measures 21


(20, 19, 18, 17, 16)", [53 (51, 48, 46, 43, 41) cm] from shoulder or desired length to cuff. Bind off.

Sew side and sleeve seams.

Abbreviations

K = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch (es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
