



Cuff to Cuff Cardigan

Designed by Julie Farmer.

Directions are for size XSmall; changes for sizes Small, Medium, Large, XLarge and XXLarge are in parentheses.

Finished Bust: 34 (38, 42, 46, 50, 54)”.
Finished Length: 23 (23, 23, 25¾, 27½, 27½)”.

RED HEART® “Eco-Ways®”: 4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 8) balls 3380 Cornflower.

Knitting Needles: 5.5mm [US 9].
Cable needle, stitch markers (2), yarn needle.
Optional: pin for closure.

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4”; 24 rows = 4” in Cable pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge given.**

Special Abbreviations

4/4 LC = Slip next 4 sts to cable needle, hold to front; k4; k4 from cable needle.

Inc = Increase 1 stitch by k or p into front and back of same stitch.

NOTE

Cardigan is made vertically from right sleeve cuff to left sleeve cuff.

K3, p3 Rib (worked over a multiple of 6 sts)

Row 1 (Right Side): * K3, p3; repeat from * across.
Repeat Row for K3, p3 rib pattern.

Cable Pattern (worked over 12 sts)

Row 1 (Cable Row) (Right Side): * 4/4 LC, k4; repeat from *.
Rows 2 - 10: Work even in St st.
Repeat Rows 1 – 10 for Cable pattern.

CARDIGAN

Right Sleeve

Cast on 72 (72, 72, 84, 90, 90) sts.

Work in K3, p3 rib for 3”, end by working a right side row.

Next Row: Keeping continuity of pattern, * rib 2, inc; repeat from * across—96 (96, 96, 112, 120, 120) sts.

Begin St st with a k row, work 2 rows even.

Setup Pattern

Next Row (Right Side): K2 (2, 2, 4, 2, 2), place marker, work Row 1 of Cable pattern across row to last 10 (10, 10, 12, 10, 10) sts, 4/4 LC, place marker, k2 (2, 2, 4, 2, 2).

Keeping sts between markers in Cable pattern, work in pattern as established until piece measures 4 (4, 4, 5, 5½, 5½)” from beginning, end by working a wrong side row.

Cast on 66 (66, 66, 72, 78, 78) sts at end of next 2 rows for back and right front – 228 (228, 228, 256, 276, 276) sts. Continue in pattern as established until next cable row.

Re-establish pattern as follows:

For Sizes XSmall, Small, Medium, XLarge, and XXLarge only

K8 (8, 8, 8, 8), place marker, work Row 1 of Cable pattern across row to last 4 (4, 4, 4, 4) sts, place marker, k4 (4, 4, 4, 4).

For Size Large only

K4, place marker, work Row 1 of Cable pattern across row to last 12 sts, 4/4 LC, place marker, k4.

For all Sizes

Work in pattern as established until piece measures 5½ (6¼, 7¼, 8, 8¾, 9½)” from last cast on row, end by working a wrong side row.



CUFF TO CUFF CARDIGAN | KNIT

Next Row: Bind off 114 (114, 114, 128, 138, 138) sts at beginning of row, work in pattern to end—114 (114, 114, 128, 138, 138) sts.

Continue even in pattern for 6 (6½, 6½, 7, 7½, 8)”, end by working a wrong side row cast on 114 (114, 114, 128, 138, 138) sts at end of row for left front—228 (228, 228, 256, 276, 276) sts.

Re-establish pattern and work even until piece measures 5½ (6¼, 7¼, 8, 8¾, 9½)” from last cast on row, end by working a wrong side row.

Bind off 66 (66, 66, 72, 78, 78) sts at beginning of next 2 rows—96 (96, 96, 112, 120, 120) sts.

Left Sleeve

Continue in pattern for 1 (1, 1, 2, 2½, 2½)”, end by working a right side row.

Next Row: * P2, p2tog; repeat from * across—72 (72, 72, 84, 90, 90) sts.

Work in K3, p3 rib for 3”, end by working a wrong side row. Bind off in pattern.

FINISHING

Sew sleeve and side seams.

Right Front Band

With right side facing, and beginning at bottom of right front, pick up and k90 (90, 90, 96, 102, 102) sts. Work in K3, p3 rib for 3 (3¼, 3¼, 3½, 3¾, 4)”, end by working a wrong side row. Bind off in pattern.

Left Front Band

With right side facing and beginning at top of left front, work same as for right front.

Collar

With right side facing, pick up and k15 (17, 17, 21, 22, 24) sts along top of right front border, 36 (38, 38, 42, 46, 48) sts along back neck, 15 (17, 17, 21, 22, 24) sts along top of left front edging—66 (72, 72, 84, 90, 96) sts. Work in K3, p3 rib for 7 (7, 7, 7½, 8, 8)”, end by working a wrong side row. Bind off in pattern. Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: **K** = knit; **mm** = millimeters, **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **St st** = Stockinette stitch (k on right side rows, p on wrong side rows); **tog** = together; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
