

## Monique's Tunic

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium, Large, XLarge and XXLarge are in parentheses.

Finished Chest: $39(43,47,51,55)$ ".
Finished Length: 28½ (283/4, 29, 291⁄2, 30)".
RED HEART® Boutique ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ "Eclipse ${ }^{\text {TM } ": ~} 9$ (10, 11, 12 13) balls 9365 Mountain Mist.

Knitting Needles: 5.5 mm [US 9] and 6.5mm [US 101⁄2]. Stitch holders (3), yarn needle.

GAUGE: 16 sts $=4 " ; 24$ rows $=4$ " in St st on larger needles. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

## Special Abbreviations

Skp = Slip 1 st knitwise, k1, psso.
Ssk = Slip next 2 sts knitwise, one at a time to right needle; insert point of left needle into the fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together from this position.

K2, p2 Rib (Multiple of 4 + 2 sts)
Row 1 (Right Side): K2, * p2, k2; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 2: P2, * k2, p2; repeat from * to end of row.
Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for K2, p2 rib.

## SWEATER

## Back

With smaller needles, cast on $78(86,94,102,110)$ sts.
Begin with Row 1, work 16 rows in K2, p2 rib.
Change to larger needles, begin St st with a k row and work even until piece measures 19 " from beginning, end with a wrong side row.

## Shape Armholes

Bind off $6(7,8,9,10)$ sts at beginning of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at each end every row $3(3,3,3,5)$ times, then every other row $2(3,4,5,5)$ times-56 $(60,64,68,70)$ sts.

Work even until armhole measures $81 / 2(83 / 4,9,91 / 2,10)$ " from beginning, end by working a wrong side row.

## Shape Shoulders

Bind off $5(5,6,6,6)$ sts at beginning of next 4 rows, then bind off $5(6,5,7,7)$ sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Slip remaining $26(28,30,30,32)$ sts onto holder for back neck.

## Front

With smaller needles, cast on $78(86,94,102,110)$ sts. Begin with Row 1, work 16 rows in K2, p2 rib.
Change to larger needles, begin St st with a $k$ row and work even until piece measures 17" from beginning, end by working a wrong side row.

## Divide for Neck

Next Row: K38 $(42,46,50,54)$ sts, slip next 2 sts onto holder for neckband, slip remaining $38(42,46,50,54)$ sts onto another holder for right front. Continue on sts for left front, p 1 row even.

## Shape V Neck and Armhole

Next Row: K across row to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. Repeat last row every other row 1 time, then every fourth row 5 (7, $8,7,9)$ times, then every sixth row $5(4,4,5,4)$ times AND AT THE SAME TIME when piece measures same as Back to armhole, ending with a wrong side row, Shape Armhole as follows: bind off $6(7,8,9,10)$ sts at armhole edge, then dec 1 st at same edge every row $3(3,3,3,5)$ times, then
every other row $2(3,4,5,5)$ times-15 $(16,17,19,19)$ sts. Work even until piece measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, end by working a wrong side row.

## Shape Shoulder

Bind off $5(5,6,6,6)$ sts at shoulder edge twice. Work 1 row even. Bind off remaining $5(6,5,7,7)$ sts.

With right side facing, attach yarn to $38(42,46,50,54)$ sts for right front and $k$ to end of row. P 1 row even.

## Sleeves (Make 2)

With smaller needles, cast on $42(46,50,54,58)$ sts.
Begin with Row 1, work 16 rows in K2, p2 rib.
Change to larger needles, begin St st with a k row and work 2 rows even. Shape sleeve by inc 1 st at each end next row, then every other row $6(7,8,9,9)$ times - $56(62$, $68,74,78)$ sts. Work even until piece measures $7(71 / 2,8$, $9,9)$ " from beginning, end by working a wrong side row.

## Shape Cap

Bind off $3(4,4,5,5)$ sts at beginning of next 2 rows-50 $(54,60,64,68)$ sts. Dec 1 st at each end next row, then every other row 17 (17, 16, 16, 16) times, then every row 1 (3, 7, 9, 11) times. Bind off remaining 12 sts.


FINISHING
Sew shoulder seams. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams.

## Neckband

With smaller needles, begin at shoulder edge, pickup and k64 (68, 68, 72, 72) sts down left neck edge, k2 sts from holder, pickup and k64 $(68,68,72,72)$ sts up right neck edge, $k$ across $26(28,30,30,32)$ from back neck holder and dec $2(0,2,2,0)$ sts evenly across-154 (166, 166, 174, 178) sts.
Row 1: P2 * k2, p2; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 2: Rib to within 1 st of 2 center sts; k2tog, skp, work to end of row.
Row 3: Rib to within 1 st of 2 center sts; p2tog-tbl, p2tog, work to end of row.
Repeat Rows 2 and 3 twice more. Bind off loosely in rib. Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: Dec = decrease; inc = increase; $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{p}=$ purl; psso = pass slipped st over; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); St st = Stockinette st (k on right side rows, $p$ on wrong side rows); tbl = through back loop; $\boldsymbol{t o g}=$ together; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
