## What you will need:

RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Boutique ${ }^{\text {mw }}$
Unforgettable: 2 (3, 3, 4, 5, 5)
balls 3965 Candied
Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8] circular needles, $24^{\prime \prime}$ ( 60 cm ) and $32^{\prime \prime}(80 \mathrm{~cm})$ long

Stitch marker, yarn needle
GAUGE: 18 sts $=4$ " $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in Eyelet Rib slightly stretched. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Boutique Unforgettable ${ }^{\text {rm }}$, Art. E793 available in $3.50 \mathrm{z}(100 \mathrm{~g}), 280 \mathrm{yd}$ ( 256 m ) balls


## Teen Endless Circle Vest

This young look is fun to knit and perfect for those who want to start knitting projects other than hats and scarfs. It is made in one piece so there is no seaming.

Directions are for size XSmall; changes for sizes Small, Medium, Large, X-Large, and XX-Large are in parentheses

To Fit Bust: 32 (36, 40, 44, 48, 52)" (81.5 (91.5, 101.5, 112, 122, 132) cm)

Finished Back Width: $15 ½(18,20,22,241 ⁄ 2$, $261 / 2$ )" (39.5 (45.5, 51, 56, 62, 67.5) cm)

## Special Stitches

kfb (Knit into front and back) = Knit next st but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same st and remove from needle. ssk = Slip next 2 stitches, one at a time, as if to knit to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

## Pattern Stitch

Eyelet Rib (multiple of 5 sts)
Rounds 1-3: *K3, p2; repeat from * around.
Round 4: *K2tog, yo, k1, p2; repeat from * around.
Rounds 5-7: *K3, p2; repeat from * around.
Round 8: *K1, yo, ssk; p2 repeat from * around.
Repeat Rounds 1-8 for Eyelet Rib.

## 1x1 Rib (over even number of sts)

Row 1 (right side): K1, p1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 2: Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts to end of row.
Repeat Row 2 for 1x1 Rib.

## Notes

1. Vest is worked in one piece beginning with rectangular back piece.
2. Back piece is worked back and forth in rows. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches. Work back and forth in rows as if working with straight needles.
3. Back piece is folded in half and outer border worked in rounds over cast-on and bind-off edges.

## BACK

With shorter circular needle, cast on 70 (80,
$90,100,110,120$ ).
Work in $1 \times 1$ Rib until piece measures 16 (17, $17,18,18,19)$ " (40.5 (43, 43, 45.5, 45.5, $48.5) \mathrm{cm}$ ) from beginning. Do not bind off and do not cut yarn.

## Outer Border

Change to longer needle.
Fold back in half, bringing cast-on edge up to match last row. Pick up and k70 (80, 90, 100, $110,120)$ sts across cast-on edge-140 (160 180, 200, 220, 240) sts. Place marker for beginning of round and join to work in rounds. Round 1: Kfb in each st around-280 (320, 360, 400, 440, 480) sts.
Work even in Eyelet Rib until outer border measures $7(7,7 ½, 7 ½, 8,9) "(18(18,19,19$, $20.5,23) \mathrm{cm}$ ).
Bind off in pattern.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{k 2 t o g}=$ knit next 2 sts together; $\mathbf{p}$ = purl; st(s) = stich(es); yo = yarn over; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
