What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver® Jumbo:

2 skeins 784 Bonbon Print

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 3 skeins 784 Bonbon Print

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8] 29" long

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 18 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 24 rows 4" [10 cm] in Mistake Stitch Pattern (slightly stretched). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.**

SHOP KIT



One-Row Baby Blanket

Here's the perfect blanket to knit while doing other things like talking with friends or watching a gripping movie. There is only one-row to remember, so you won't have to be checking a pattern. Blanket measures: 29" x 29" [74 cm x 74 cm]

Special Abbreviations

K2 = Knit 2 sts. **P2** = Purl 2 sts.

NOTE

Work back and forth in rows on circular needle, do not join.

TIPS & HINTS

Join a new skein of yarn when there are approximately 6" [15 cm] of yarn left from the old skein, also leaving a 6" [15 cm] tail of yarn with the joined yarn. Weave these ends in neatly on the same side of the fabric in a zigzag pattern for a few inches, and then trim off excess.

Mistake Stitch Pattern

Row 1: *K2, P2; repeat from *, end K2, P1. Repeat Row 1 for Mistake Stitch Pattern.

BLANKET

Cast on 155 sts.

Begin Row 1 of Mistake Stitch Pattern.

Continue in Pattern until piece measures 29" [74 cm] from cast on edge.

Last Row: Bind off all sts.

FINISHING Weave in ends.

k = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st (s)** = stitch(es; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
