



Happy day dress

Oh what fun it is to dress a little one in this pretty knit dress. It will span the seasons with the addition of a long sleeve tee and leggings. And best of all, this yarn is washable!

Instructions are for size 6 months; changes for sizes 12 and 18 months are in parentheses.

Finished Measurements Chest: 20¾ (21½, 22½)". Length: 16 (17½, 19)".

STITCH NATION by Debbie Stoller™ "Washable Ewe™": 2 (2, 3) balls 3215 Duckling

Circular Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8] - 16" and 24". Stitch markers, stitch holders, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4"; 22 rows = 4" in 4-st Razor Shell pattern, after blocking. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

SPECIAL TECHNIOUES

8-st Razor Shell

Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: * Yo, k2, slip 1, k2tog, psso, k2, yo, k1; repeat from * around.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 for pattern.

6-st Razor Shell

Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: * Yo, k1, slip 1, k2tog, psso, k1, yo, k1; repeat from * around.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 for pattern.

4-st Razor Shell

Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: * Yo, slip 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k1; repeat from * around. Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 for pattern.

DRESS

Skirt

Note: Change to shorter circular needle when needed. Cast on 176 (184, 192) sts. Place marker and join in a round. Work in 8-st Razor Shell pattern for 4 (5, 5½)", ending with Round 2.

Decrease Round: * K2, k2tog; repeat from * around - 132 (138, 144) sts. Work in 6-st Razor Shell pattern, beginning with Round 2, for 4 (4½, 5)" more, ending with Round 2.



Decrease Round: * K1, k2tog; repeat from * around – 88 (92, 96) sts. Work in 4-st Razor Shell pattern, beginning with Round 2, for 3 (4, 4)" more, ending with Round 1.

Divide for Front and Back

Back-Shape Armholes

Place a second marker 44 (46, 48) sts from first marker. Bind off 3 sts, work in pattern (Round 2) to second marker, turn; place remaining 44 (46, 48) sts on holder for Front. Bind off 3 sts at beginning of next row and purl to end — 38 (40, 42) sts.

Continue in 4-st Razor Shell pattern, working back and forth in rows and Purling all wrong side rows. Work any extra sts at ends of rows in St st.

Dec 1 st each end of row every other row 3 times -32 (34, 36) sts. Work even in pattern until armholes measure 4 (4, $4\frac{1}{2}$)", end P row.

Shape Shoulders and Neck

Bind off 3 (3, 4) sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Bind off 3 sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Bind off 2 (3, 3) sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Place remaining 16 sts on a holder for back neck.

Front

Place held 44 (46, 48) sts on needles. Shape armholes as for Back and work even in pattern until armholes measure 2", end P row.

Shape Neck and Shoulders

Work in pattern across first 11 (12, 13) sts, join a second ball of yarn and bind off center 10 sts, work in pattern to end. Dec 1 st each neck edge every other row 3 times – 8 (9, 10) sts. Work even until Front measures same as Back to shoulder shaping. Shape shoulders as for Back.

Sleeves

Cast on 33 sts. Work in 4-st Razor Shell pattern as follows: Row 1 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Row 2: K1, * yo, slip 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k1; repeat from * to end. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for 1", end Purl row.

Shape Cap

Bind off 3 sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end of every other row 3 times – 21 sts.

For size 18 months only: Work 2 rows even in pattern.

For all sizes: Dec 1 st each end of every row 4 times — 13 sts. Bind off 2 sts at beginning of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 5

FINISHING

Sew right shoulder seam.

Neck Trim

With right side facing, pick up and knit 55 (55, 59) sts around neck edge. Work in ribbing as follows:

Row 1 (Wrong Side): P1, * k1, p1; repeat from * to end. Row 2: K1, * p1, k1; repeat from * to end.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for ribbing for ¾". Bind off loosely in ribbing.

Sew left shoulder and neck trim seam. Set in sleeves; sew side and sleeve seams. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: dec = decrease; k = knit; k2tog = knit 2 together; mm = millimeters, p = purl; sl 1-k2tog-psso = slip 1 purlwise, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over; st(s) = stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; yo = yarn over; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
