Sizes U.S. $6(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ and U.S. $8(5 \mathrm{~mm})$ Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.

M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop.


## SIZES

## To fit head circumference:

Preemie (Newborn-6/12 mos18/24 mos) 9½" (12-16-171/2)" [24 (30.5-40.5-44.5) cm]

## GAUGES

18 sts and 24 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] with larger needles in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size Preemie. If changes are necessary for sizes Newborn, 6/12 or 18/24 mos the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

## "arnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

With smaller needles, cast on 46 (58-74-82) sts.
1st row: K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing 4 (5-6-7) times more.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 3 ( $3^{11 / 2-4} 1 / 2-5$ )" [7.5 (9-11.5-12.5) cm], ending on a purl row and dec 3 (3-1-3) st(s) evenly across last row. 43 (55-7379) sts.

Shape top: 1 st rnd: K1. *K2tog. K5 (7-10-11). Rep from * to end of row. 37 (49-67-73) sts.

## 2nd and alt rows: Purl.

3rd row: K1. *K2tog. K4 (6-9-10). Rep from * to end of row. 31 (43-61-67) sts.
5th row: K1. *K2tog. K3 (5-8-9). Rep from * to end of row. 25 (37-55-61) sts.
7th row: K1. *K2tog. K2 (4-7-8). Rep from * to end of row. 19 (31-49-55) sts.
8th row: As 2nd row.

Cont in same manner, dec 6 sts on next and every following alt row until there are 13 sts rem. Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew back seam.
