RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Supersaver® ${ }^{\circledR} 1$ skein 356 Amethyst A (Dress) and 1 skein 312 Black B (Hat)

RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Boutique Sashay Mini ${ }^{m "}$ : 1 Ball 2949 Glow C (Flowers)

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Knitting Needles: 5 mm [US 8] and 5.5 mm [US 9]

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 9mm [US N -13]

Yarn needle, Stitch holder, purchased headband (Goody \#09294, black), Polyester Fiberfil (stuffing for hat)

GAUGE: 15 sts $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}] ; 21$ rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Stockinette St. on larger size needles. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

(a) RED HEART® ${ }^{\oplus}$ Sashay Mini": Art E782N super bulky available in multicolor 3.5 oz ( 99 g ), 42 yd (39 m) balls


## Baby Witch Dress \& Hat

Perfect for taking photos at the pumpkin patch, this little witch will be the center of attention at any party. Dress and hat on headband are knitted with crocheted ruffle flowers.

Directions are for size 6 months. Changes for sizes $(12,24)$ months are in parentheses. Sample shown is size 12 months.

## Measurements

Finished Chest: 21½ (22½, 24½)" 55 [57 $62 \mathrm{~cm}]$
Finished Length: $15(16,18) " 38$ [41, 46 cm$]$

## SPECIAL STITCHES

M1 = Make 1 (Increase) - Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and knit strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole.
ssk = Slip next 2 stitches, one at a time as if to knit, to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

## DRESS

Back
Using A and larger size needles, cast on 54 $(58,62)$ sts.
Row 1-4: Work in Garter St to end of row. Row 5 (Right Side): Work in Stockinette St to end of row.

## Shape Sides

Next Rows: Continue working Stockinette St decreasing 1 st at each end of Right Side every 6 th row $7(8,8)$ times as follows: Knit 2 sts, ssk, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. Continue as established until $40(42,46)$ sts remain and piece measures $101 / 2(11,12) " 27[28,30 \mathrm{~cm}]$ from beginning, end with a Wrong Side row.

## Shape Armholes

Next Rows: Bind off 4 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows - $32(34,38)$ sts remain. Continue working as established until armhole measures $4 ½(5,6)$ " $11[13,15 \mathrm{~cm}]$ and total back length measures $15(16,18) " 38[41,46$ $\mathrm{cm}]$ from beginning. Bind off all sts.

## Front

Using A and larger size needles, cast on 54 $(58,62)$ sts.
Rows 1-4:.Work in Garter St to end of row.
Row 5 (Right Side): Work in Stockinette St to end of row.

## Shape Sides

Next Rows: Continue working Stockinette St decreasing 1 st at each end of Right Side every 6 th row $7(8,8)$ times as follows: Knit 2 sts, ssk, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. Continue as established until $40(42,46)$ sts remain and piece measures $101 / 2(11,12)$ " 27 [28, 30 cm$]$ from beginning, ending with a Wrong Side row.

## Shape Armholes

Next Rows: Bind off 4 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows - $32(34,38)$ sts remain. Continue working as established until piece measures $12(13,15)$ " $30[33,38 \mathrm{~cm}]$ from beginning.

## Divide for Neck

Next Row: With Right Side facing, work across first $11(11,12)$ sts, place center $10(12,14)$ sts on holder, work to end of row.

## Shape Neck

Working each shoulder separately, bind off 1 st at neck edge every other Right Side row 3 times - $8(8,9)$ sts remain at each shoulder. When piece measures same as back, bind off all sts.

## Sleeves (make 2)

Using A and larger size needles, cast on 26 $(28,32)$ sts.
Rows 1-4:.Work in Garter St to end of row.

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Row 5 (Right Side): Work in Stockinette St and increase 1 st at each end every 6th row 4 $(5,7)$ times - $34(38,46)$ sts.
Continue working in Stockinette St until sleeve measures $7(8,10)$ " $18[20,25 \mathrm{~cm}]$ from beginning. Bind off all sts.

## Neckband

Using yarn needle and A , sew right shoulder seam.
Using A and larger size needles, with Right Side facing, pick up $52(54,58)$ sts along left front neck edge, front holder, right front neck edge and back neck.
Work in Garter St for 4 rows.
Bind off knitwise with Right Side facing.
Using yarn needle and $\mathbf{A}$, sew left shoulder seam. Set in sleeves. Sew sleeve and side seams.

## FLOWERS (make 3-2 for corsage and

 1 for hat)With crochet hook and C, ch 5 ; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
Round 1: [Ch 5, sc in next st] 5 times; join with slip st in base of beginning $\mathrm{ch}-5$.
Fasten off.
Using yarn needle and $\mathbf{A}$, attach 2 flowers to left shoulder by making a French Knot in the center of the flower

## HAT

Using B and smaller size needles, cast on 2 sts.
First Row (Right Side): Knit.
Next Row (Wrong Side): Purl.

## Shape Hat

Row 1: K1, M1, k1 - 3 sts.
Row 2 and all Wrong Side Rows to brim: Purl.
Row 3: K1, M1, k1, M1, k1-5 sts.

Row 5: [K1, M1] 4 times, k1-9 sts.
Row 7: Knit.
Row 9: [K1, M1, k3, M1] twice, k1 - 13 sts.
Row 11: Knit.
Row 13: [K1, M1, k5, M1] twice, k 1 - 17 sts Row 15: Knit.
Row 17: [K1, M1, k7, M1] twice, k1 - 21 sts. Row 19: Knit
Row 21: [K1, M1, k9, M1] twice, k1 - 25 sts. Row 23: Knit.
Row 25: [K1, M1, k11, M1] twice, k1 - 29 sts.
Row 27: [K7, M1] 3 times, k8 - 32 sts.
Row 29: K1, [k3, M1]10 times, k1 - 42 sts.

## Brim

Rows 30-32: Knit.
Row 33: K1, [k4, M1]10 times, k1 - 52 sts.
Rows 34-36: Knit.
Row 37: K1, [k5, M1] 10 times, k1 - 62 sts.
Rows 38 and 39: Knit.
Bind off all sts loosely knitwise.
Cut yarn leaving a tail approximately 15"
[38 cm].
Sew brim and hat seam.

## Headband

Stuff hat with polyester fiberfil. Using yarn needle and $\mathbf{B}$,
sew one flower to side of hat. Attach hat to headband.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends, block lightly to shape dress and hat.

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; k2tog = knit next 2 sts together; $\mathbf{p}=$ purl; $\mathbf{s c}=$ single crochet; $\operatorname{st}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
