

## Baby Jacket and Bonnet

Cardigan directions are for size 6 months; changes for sizes 12 months and 18 months are in parentheses.
Bonnet directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses.

Finished Chest: 22 (24, 261/2)".
Finished Length: $83 / 4(93 / 4,101 / 4)^{\prime \prime}$.
RED HEART® "Smoothie ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ": Cardigan - 2 balls 4390 White; Bonnet - 1 ball 4390 White.

Circular Knitting Needles: 4.5 mm [US 7] 29".
Knitting Needles: 4.5 mm [US 7].
Spare knitting needle, stitch holders (2), yarn needle, 4 buttons, silk ribbon, silk rosette.

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4"; 40 rows $=4$ " in Garter st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

## NOTES

Jacket is worked back and forth in rows. Circular needles are used to accommodate large number of stitches. Back and Fronts are worked in one piece to the armholes, then joined with sleeves to work yoke.

## JACKET <br> Body

With circular needles, cast on $110(121,132)$ sts.
Work even in Garter st (k every row) until piece measures $43 / 4(5,51 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ from beginning, end by working a wrong side row.

## Divide for Fronts and Back

K26 $(29,32)$ sts for Right Front, bind off 6 sts, $\mathrm{k} 46(51,56)$ sts for Back, bind off 6 sts, k26 $(29,32)$ sts for Left Front. Place all sts on a spare needle.

## Sleeves (make 2)

With knitting needles, cast on $22(28,30)$ sts.
Begin Garter st and shape sleeve by inc 1 st at beginning and end of every 16 th (8th, 10th) row
$2(5,5)$ times-26 $(38,40)$ sts.
Work even until piece measures $43 / 4(6,7)$ " from beginning, end by working a right side row.
Bind off 3 sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Place remaining $20(32,34)$ sts on holder.

## Shape Yoke

With wrong side facing and circular needles, p across sts left waiting on spare needle and holders as follows: 26 (29, 32) sts from Left front, $20(32,34)$ sts from Left Sleeve, $46(51,56)$ sts from Back decreasing $2(1,2)$ sts evenly across, $20(32,34)$ sts from Right Sleeve, $26(29,32)$ sts from Right Front-136 $(172,186)$ sts.
Row 1 (Right Side): Knit.
Row 2: K8 (9, 8), [k2tog, k5 (6, 6,)] 17 (19, 21) times, k2tog, k7 $(9,8)-118(152,164)$ sts.
Row 3 (Buttonhole Row): P2 (2, 3), yo, p2tog, p to end.
Rows 4 and 5: Knit.
Row 6: Purl.
Row 7: Knit.
Row 8: K7 $(8,7),[k 2$ tog, $\mathrm{k} 4(5,5)] 17(19,21)$ times, k2tog, k7 (9, 8)-100 (132, 142) sts.
Rows 9-13: Repeat Rows 3-7, omitting buttonhole.
Row 14: K7 (8, 7), [k2tog, k3 $(4,4)] 17(19,21)$ times, k2tog, k6 (8, 7)-82 (112, 120) sts.
Rows 15-19: Repeat Rows 3-7.
Row 20: K6 (7, 6), [k2tog, k2 $(3,3)] 17(19,21)$ times, k2tog, k6 $(8,7)-64(92,98)$ sts.

Rows 21 - 25: Repeat Rows 3 - 7, omitting buttonhole.
Row 26: $\mathrm{K} 6(7,6)$, $[k 2$ tog, $k 1(2,2)] 17(19,21)$ times,
k2tog, k5 $(7,6)-46(72,76)$ sts.

## For sizes 12 and 18 mos only

Rows 27-31: Repeat Rows 3-7.
Row 32: K6 (5), [k2tog, k1] 19 (21) times, k2tog, k7 (6)-52 (54) sts.

## For all sizes

Knit 1 row even.
Next Row (Buttonhole Row): K across row to last $4(4,5)$ sts, k2tog, yo, k2 (2, 3).
Knit 3 rows even. Bind off.

FINISHING
Sew sleeve and side seams. Sew on buttons to correspond to buttonholes.

## BONNET

With circular needles, cast on $51(61,67)$ sts.
Row 1 (Wrong Side): Knit.
Row 2: Purl.
Rows 3 and 4: Knit.
Row 5: Purl.
Row 6: Knit.
Rows 7-12: Repeat Rows 1-6.
Work even in Garter st (k every row) until piece measures $3(31 / 2,4)$ " from beginning, end by working a wrong side row.

## Back Panel

Bind off $19(21,23)$ sts at beginning of next 2 rows-13 (19, 21 ) sts. Continue even for $31 / 2(4,41 / 2)$ ", end by working a wrong side row. Bind off.

FINISHING
Fold bonnet in half and sew seams on each side of center back panel.

With right side facing, pick up and $\mathrm{k} 45(55,61)$ sts across lower edge of bonnet. Work 4 rows in Garter st. Bind off.

Cut 2 lengths silk ribbon and sew one to each side, folding cut end under twice. Attach ribbon rosette as desired.
