# What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 2 (2, 2, 2) skein 1944 Fruit Punch A and 1 skein 1601 Lettuce B.

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 5 mm [US 8] straight, double-pointed, and circular needle 16" (41 cm) long.

Stitch marker, yarn needle, stitch holder

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" (10 cm); 20 rows = 4" (10 cm), in Stockinette st (knit on Right Side, purl on Wrong Side). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® With Love™, Art. E400 available in solid color

7oz (198g), 370 yd (338m) and multicolor 5oz (141g), 230 yd (211m) skeins.



# Flared Jumper

Keep your little fashionista in style with this darling knit jumper! Bright colors will make her happy and you'll love the softness and easy care.

Directions are for size 2 years. Changes for sizes 4 years, 6 years, and 8 years are in parentheses.

**To Fit Chest:** 20-22 (22-24, 24-26, 26-28)" [51-56 (56-61, 61-66, 66-71) cm] **Finished Chest:** 24 (26, 28, 30)" [56 (66, 71, 76) cm]

**Finished Length:** 16 (17¾, 19½, 21½)" [38 (45, 50, 54) cm]

#### **Special Stitches**

ssk = Slip next two stitches as if to knit to right needle one at a time, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together in this position.

w&t (wrap and turn)—worked on a purl row: Work to designated st: slip next stitch to right needle, bring yarn to back between needles, slip the stitch back to left needle. Turn work to begin working back in the other direction. Note: When working the wrapped stitch in a later row, pick up the wrap from behind and place on needle and work it together with the wrapped stitch.

#### Stripe Pattern worked in rounds

**Rounds 1–22:** With **A**, knit. Do not cut **A**, carry up wrong side until next needed.

Round 23: With B knit.

Round 24: With B purl. Cut B.

Repeat these 24 rounds for Stripe Pattern worked in rounds.

# Stripe Pattern worked in rows

Rows 1–22: With A, work in Stockinette st (knit on Right Side, purl on Wrong side). Do not cut A, carry up side of piece until next needed. Rows 23 and 24: With B, knit. Cut B. Repeat these 24 rows for Stripe Pattern worked in rows.

#### **Notes**

- 1. Skirt is worked sideways using short rows to create flare.
- 2. Stitches are picked up across one edge of skirt for bodice.
- Bodice is worked in rounds, from top of skirt to underarms. The piece is then divided and front and back worked separately, back and forth in rows.

# **SKIRT**

**Notes:** Beginning of Right Side rows is waist edge of skirt. Three stitches of Garter st (knit every row) are worked at the hem edge (end of Right Side rows).

With **B**, cast on 36 (42, 48, 54) sts.

Knit 1 row.

Change to A.

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit.

Row 2: K3, purl to end of row.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: K3, purl to last 12 sts, w&t.

Row 5: Knit.

**Row 6:** K3, purl to end of row. Note: When working the wrapped stitches, pick up the wrap from behind and place on left needle, purl it together with the wrapped stitch.

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: K3, purl to end of row Rows 9-16: Repeat Rows 1-8 Rows 17-22: Repeat Rows 1-6

Change to B.

Row 23: With B knit

Row 24: With B knit. Cut B.

Change to A.

Continue repeating Rows 1–24, until hem edge (end of Right Side rows) measures about 30 (33, 36, 39)" [76 (84, 91) cm], end with a Row 6. 14 or 22. Bind off.

Sew cast-on edge to bind-off edge, for side seam.

**SHOP KIT** 



#### **BODICE**

With Right Side facing, circular needle and **B**, beginning at side seam, pick up and k96 (104, 112, 120) sts evenly spaced around top edge of skirt. Join for working in the round place marker for beginning of round.

Purl 1 round. Cut B.

Attach **A** and work Stripe Pattern worked in rounds until bodice measures 3" (8 cm), end with any odd-numbered round.

#### **Divide for Front and Backs**

**Dividing Round:** Work across first 38 (42, 46, 50) sts (for front), bind off next 10 sts (for underarm), work across next 38 (42, 46, 50) sts (for back), bind off last 10 sts.

Change to corresponding row in Stripe Pattern worked in rows, and continue to work in pattern throughout.

Row 1 (Right Side): Working across front sts, k1, ssk, knit to 3 sts before end of front sts, k2tog, k1; join 2nd ball of yarn and work across back sts; k1, ssk, k to 3 sts before end of back, k2tog, k1—36 (40, 44, 48) sts each on front and back.

Work front and back at the same time, using separate balls of yarn.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Work even across back sts, then work even across front sts.

Row 3: K1, ssk, knit to 3 sts before end of front sts, k2tog, k1; working across back sts, k1, ssk, knit to 3 sts before end of back, k2tog, k1—34 (38, 42, 46) sts each on front and back.

Rows 4–9: Repeat last 2 rows 3 more times—28 (32, 36, 40) sts each on front and back.

Work even in pattern as established on both front and back until armhole measures 2 (2½,  $2\frac{1}{2}$ , 3)" [8 (6, 63.3, 8) cm] end with a Wrong Side row.

#### **Shape Front Neck**

Work over front sts only.

Row 1 (Right Side): Work across first 8 (10, 11, 13) sts of front, join another ball of yarn and bind off center 12 (12, 14, 14) sts, work across remaining 8 (10, 11, 13) sts of front—8 (10, 11, 13) sts on each side of front neck. Place back stitches on holder Work both sides of front at the same time, using separate balls of yarn.

Row 2(Wrong Side): Work even across both sides.

Row 3: Knit to 3 sts before end of first side, k2tog, k1; on 2nd side, k1, ssk, knit to end of 2nd side—7 (9, 10, 12) sts on each side.

Rows 4 and 5: Repeat last 2 rows—6 (8, 9, 11) sts on each side.

Work even in pattern as established on both sides until neck is 2" (5 cm) deep. Bind off.

# **Shape Back Neck**

Place back stitches on needle and work back same as front neck.

## **FINISHING**

Sew shoulder seams.

## **Neck Edging**

With Right Side facing, circular or double-pointed needles and **B**, beginning at shoulder seam, pick up and knit sts evenly spaced around neck edge (you should work approximately 56 (56, 60, 60) sts). Purl 1 round. Bind off.

## **Armhole Edging**

With Right Side facing, double-pointed needles and **B**, beginning at underarm, pick up and knit sts evenly spaced around armhole edge (you should work approximately 42 (44, 46, 48) sts). Purl 1 round. Bind off.

Weave in ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** A, B, C and D = color A, color B, color C, and color D;  $\mathbf{k} = \text{knit}$ ;  $\mathbf{k2tog} = \text{knit}$  next 2 sts together;  $\mathbf{p} = \text{purl}$ ;  $\mathbf{st(s)} = \text{stitch(es)}$ .
