



Mom & Daughter Love Mitts

*With this pattern warm your heart and your hands.
Make a pair for you and your little one With Love.*

Designed by Sara Harper.

Directions are for child size; changes for adult size are in parentheses.

Finished Length: 8 (12)"; **Circumference:** 6 (8)"

RED HEART® With Love™: 1 skein each 1703 Candy Pink **A** and 1909 Holly Berry **B** will make both a child and an adult pair of mittens.

Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 3.75mm [US 5] and 4.5mm [US 7].

Yarn needle, stitch markers, stitch holder.

GAUGE: 18 sts = 4"; 28 rounds = 4" in St st with larger needles. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

Special Abbreviation

M1 (make one stitch) = Lift running thread before next stitch onto left needle and knit into the back loop.

MITTS (Make 2)

Cuff

With smaller needles and **A (B)**, cast on 24 (36) sts, divided evenly on 3 dpns; join to work in the round, being careful sts are not twisted.

Round 1: * K1, P1; repeat from * around.

Repeat Round 1 until 3 (4)" from beginning. Change to larger needles and begin St st. Work even until 3½ (5)" from beginning.

Thumb Gusset

Round 1: K11 (16), pm, k1, M1, k1, pm, knit to end – 25 (37) sts.

Round 2 and All Even Rounds: Knit even.

Round 3: Knit to first marker, slip marker, M1, knit to next marker, M1, slip marker, knit to end – 27 (39) sts.

Repeat Rounds 2 and 3 until there are 31 (49) sts.

Next Round: K11 (16), place next 9 (15) sts on holder for thumb, cast on 2 sts, k to end – 24 (36) sts. Work even until piece measures 5 (11)" from beginning.





Shape Mitten Top

Round 1 and all odd rounds: Knit even

Round 2: [K4, K2tog] 4 (6) times – 20 (30) sts.

Round 4: [K3, K2tog] 4 (6) times – 16 (24) sts.

Round 6: [K2, K2tog] 4 (6) times – 12 (18) sts.

Round 7: [K1, K2tog] 4 (6) times – 8 (12) sts.

Round 8: [K2tog] 4 (6) times – 4 (6) sts. Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail. Thread through remaining stitches, pull tightly to secure. Fasten off.

Thumb

Divide 9 (15) sts from holder onto 3 dpns. Join yarn and pick up and knit 1 st over cast-on sts, knit to end of round – 10 (16) sts. Work even in St st until thumb measures 1¾ (2¼)".

Next Round: [K2tog] 5 (8) times – 5 (8) sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail. Thread through remaining stitches, pull tightly to secure. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Lay mittens flat. Using color **B (A)** and yarn needle, begin at the midpoint of the tip of the hand of the mitten and using a backstitch (or preferred decorative stitch) stitch an increasing curve that swells to almost the wrist and terminates at the midpoint of the tip of the thumb. When fingertips and thumb tips are pressed together, a heart shape will appear over the pair of mittens. Weave in ends.



RED HEART® With Love™, Art. E400, available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 390 yd (357 m) and multi-color 5 oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) skeins.
