



KNIT SKILL LEVEL INTERMEDIATE

What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 1 skein 1546 Iris

Susan Bates® Circular knitting needles: 4.5mm [US 7], 16" (40.6 cm) long

Susan Bates® Double pointed needles: One set 4.5mm [US 7]

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 24 rows = 4" [10 cm]. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

# **Carousel Hat**

Combine this cozy yarn with an interesting knit design that goes around the head like a merry-go-round. Kids will love its softness. while parents will love how easily it washes.

Directions are for child's size Small: changes for sizes Adult Large are in parentheses as necessary.

Hat circumference measures 16 (20)" [40.64 (50.8) cm] to fit 18 (22)" [45.72 (55.88) cm] head.

#### **Special Abbreviations**

LT (Left Twist) = Skip first st on left needle and knit into the back of second st; k2tog through the back loops of both sts. RT (Right Twist) = K2tog, leaving sts on left needle; knit the first st again; slip both sts from needle together.

K1tbl = K1 through the back loop.

### HAT **BRIM RIBBING**

With circular needles, cast on 64 (80) sts. Join, being careful that sts are not twisted, and begin working in the round. Place marker for beginning of round.

Rounds 1-5: (K1, P1) around for ribbing. Rounds 6-8: Work in Stockinette st (knit every row when working in the round). Round 9: Purl around.

### LATTICE STITCH PATTERN

Round 1: K1tbl, K6, \*LT, K6; repeat from \* around to last st. K1tbl. Round 2: Knit around. Round 3: \*LT, K4, RT; repeat from \* around. Round 4: Knit around. Round 5: K1,\*LT, K2, RT, K2; repeat from \* around to last 7 sts, LT, K2, RT, K1. Round 6: Knit around. Round 7: K2, LT, \*RT, K4, LT, repeat from \* around to last 4 sts, RT, K2. Round 8: Knit around.

Round 9: K3, RT, \*K6, RT; repeat from \* around to last 3 sts, K3. Round 10: Knit around. Round 11: K2, \*RT, LT, K4; repeat from \* around to last 6 sts, RT, LT, K2. Round 12: Knit around. Round 13: K1, \*RT, K2, LT, K2; repeat from \* around to last 7 sts, RT, K2, LT, K1. Round 14: Knit around. Round 15: \*RT, K4, LT; repeat from \* around. Round 16: Knit around. Round 17: Repeat Round 1. Round 18: Purl around. Rounds 19-23: Knit around.

#### SHAPE CROWN

Begin decreases for crown. Note: Change to double pointed needles when work is too small for circular needle. Round 1: (K6, K2tog) around--56 (70) sts. Round 2: Knit around. Round 3: (K5, K2tog) around--48 (60) sts. Round 4: Knit around. Round 5: (K4, K2tog) around---40 (50) sts. Round 6: Knit around. Round 7: (K3, K2tog) around—32 (40) sts. Round 8: Knit around. Round 9: (K2, K2tog) around—24 (30) sts. Round 10: Knit around. Round 11: (K1, K2tog) around—16 (20) sts. Round 12: (K2tog) around-8 (10) sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" (30.48 cm) tail. Thread onto yarn needle and run yarn through all remaining sts on needles. Draw up varn to close; fasten securely and with varn needle, weave in end.

Make one medium-size pompom and attach securely to crown of hat.

### ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit; K2tog = Knit next 2 sts together;<math>mm = millimeters; P = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
