What you will need:

RED HEART® Bear Hugs™:
2 balls 5340 Cloudy Day

Susan Bates® Knitting
Needles: 6 mm [US 10]
Yarn needle

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4" (10 cm) 20
rows = 4" (10 cm) in Garter st.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use
any size needles to obtain the
gauge

Hooded Bear Scarf with Pockets

This fun kid's scarf has a hood to keep heads warm and pockets to keep hands warm! The soft fluffy yarn is way cozy and not at all scratchy. They'll love wearing it!

SHOP KIT

Directions are for size 2-3 years.
Changes for sizes 4-5 years are in parentheses. When one number is used, it applies to both sizes.

Scarf measures: 5½" (14 cm) wide x 52 (56)" (132 (142) cm) long

Hood measures: before seaming 8 (9)" (20.25 (23) cm) wide x 22 (23)" (56 (58.5) cm) long

SPECIAL STITCH

M1 (make one) = Knit in back, then front of same stitch.

SCARF

Cast on 17 sts.
Work in garter st until piece measures 62 (66)" (157.5 (167.5) cm).
Bind off.
Weave in ends.

HOOD

Cast on 24 (27) sts.
Work in garter st until piece measures 22 (23)" (56 (58.5) cm).
Bind off.
Weave in ends.

EAR (make 4)

Cast on 3 sts.
Row 1: M1, K, M1 - 5 sts.
Row 2: M1, K3, M1 - 7 sts.
Row 3: M1, K5, M1 - 9 sts.
Row 4: M1, K7, M1 - 11 sts.
Row 5: Knit.
Continue in Garter st until piece measures 3".
Bind off.
Weave in ends.

FINISHING Ears

Holding 2 pieces together, sew around entire outer edge. Repeat to make second ear.



Hood

Fold hood in half, matching cast-on and bound-off edges. Sew one side edge together (which will become center back of hood) leaving other side edge, cast-on edge and bound-off edge unsewn.

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Assembly

Match hood's back seam to center of scarf and then sew cast-on and bound-off edges to scarf.

Sew ears to hood, using photo as a guide.

Pockets

Fold up 5" (12.5 cm) at bottom of each scarf end. Sew along side edges to form pockets.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeters; **k** = knit; **M1 (make one)** = Knit in back, then front of same stitch; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
