#### **MATERIALS**

AUSTRALIAN SUPERFINE MERINO BY CLECKHEATON (3 3) 8 PLY 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>oz (65g) balls

Colorway 1 – 54 Peacock

Colorway 2 - 08 Red

Beanie	1		2
Scarf		2	
Set	3		3

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check all yarn is from the same dye lot.

#### **NEEDLES AND EXTRAS**

- 1 set each size 5 (3.75mm) and 8 (5mm) double-pointed knitting needles for Beanie and 1 pair size 8 knitting needles for Scarf or size needed to give correct gauge.
- · cable needle.
- · yarn needle for sewing in ends.

#### **GAUGE**

19 sts and 26 rows to 4" or 10cm over stockinette st, using larger needles.

To check your gauge, using larger needles, cast on 28 sts. Work 40 rows stockinette st. Bind off loosely.

Check your gauge carefully.

If less sts to 4" or 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use larger needles.

**NOTE** - This beanie and scarf are worked on larger needles and at a looser gauge than usually recommended for this yarn.



#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**C8B** = slip next 4 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, K4, then K4 from cable needle.

**C8F** = slip next 4 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, K4, then K4 from cable needle.

**C6B** = Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, K3, then K3 from cable needle.

**C6F** = Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, K3, then K3 from cable needle.

**C5B** = Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, K3, then K2 from cable needle.

**C5F** = Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, K2, then K3 from cable needle.

**C4B** = Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle.

**C4F** = Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle.

# SUPERFINE MERINO

#### **BEANIE**

Using **set** of smaller **double-pointed** needles, cast on **100** (112) sts and divide as evenly as possible between 3 needles. Join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist cast-on edge.

BEGIN RIB -

**1st round** - \* K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

Rep 1st round 10 times.

**12th round** – Rib **0** (3), inc in next st, \* rib **8** (6), inc in next st, rep from \* to last **0** (3) sts, rib **0** (3) ... **112** (128) sts.

Change to **set** of larger **double-pointed** needles.

BEGIN CABLE PATT -

**1st round** - \* K12, P4, rep from \* to end.

**2nd round** – As 1st round.

3rd round - \* C6B, C6F, P4, rep from \* to end.

Rep 1st round 3 times.

Last 6 rounds form patt.

Work a further 11 (23) rounds.

SHAPE CROWN -

**1st round** - \* K2tog, K8, K2tog, P4, rep from \* to end ... **98** (112) sts.

2nd round - \* K10, P4, rep from \* to end.

3rd round - As 2nd round.

4th round - \* C5B, C5F, P4, rep from \* to end.

5th round - As 2nd round.

6th round - \* K10, P2tog, P2, rep from \* to end ... 91 (104) sts.

**7th round** - \* K10, P3, rep from \* to end.

Rep 7th round twice.

**10th round** - \* **C5B**, **C5F**, P3, rep from \* to end.

Rep 7th round twice.

**13th round** - \* K2tog, K6, K2tog, P3, rep from \* to end ...

77 (88) sts.

**14th round** - \* K8, P3, rep from \* to end.

15th round - As 14th round.

**16th round** - \* **C4B**, **C4F**, P3, rep from \* to end.

17th round - As 14th round.

**18th round** - \* K8, P2tog, P1, rep from \* to end ... **70** (80) sts.

 $19th \ round$  - \* K8, P2, rep from \* to end.

20th round - \* C4B, C4F, P2, rep from \* to end.

21st round - \* (K2tog) 4 times, P2, rep from \* to end ... 42 (48) sts.

**22nd round** - \* K4, P2, rep from \* to end.

23rd round - \* K4, P2tog, rep from \* to end ... 35 (40) sts.

**24th round** - \* (K2tog) twice, P1, rep from \* to end ... **21** (24) sts.

**25th round** - K**1** (0), (K2tog) **10** (12) times ... **11** (12) sts.

Break off yarn leaving a long end, thread end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

#### **FINISHING**

DO NOT PRESS. Sew in ends.

#### **SCARF**

Using pair of needles, cast on 30 sts.

BEGIN RIB-

**1st row** - P2, \* K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

**2nd row** - K2, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows 4 times, then 1st row once.

12th row - Rib 2, \* inc in next st, rib 2, rep from \* to last st, K1 ... 39 sts.

**NOTE** – To keep edges neat, join new balls of yarn 3 sts in from edge. The ends can then be sewn in vertically.

#### BEGIN CABLE PATT -

1st row - P2, K16, P3, K16, P2.

**2nd row** - K2, P16, K3, P16, K2.

3rd row - P2, C8B, C8F, P3, C8B, C8F, P2.

4th row - As 2nd row.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice.

Last 8 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until scarf measures 7" or 17cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

#### DIVIDE FOR KEYHOLE OPENING -

Next row - Patt 19, turn.

Cont on these 19 sts.

Keeping patt correct, cont until keyhole measures 2" or 5cm from beg of opening, working last row on right side.

Break off yarn. Leave sts on needle.

With right side facing, join yarn to rem 20 sts, P2tog, patt to end ... 19 sts.

Cont on these 19 sts until keyhole measures 2" or 5cm from beg of opening, ending with same patt row.

**Next row** – Patt 18, inc in next st, patt across rem sts to end ... 39 sts.

Cont in patt until scarf measures approx 34" or 85cm from beg, ending with a 1st row.

**Next row** (wrong side) – Patt 1, \* patt 2, patt 2tog, rep from \* to last 2 sts, patt 2 ... 30 sts.

#### BEGIN RIB -

Work 11 rows rib as before.

Bind off loosely in rib.

#### FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Sew in ends.
