

## Easy Knit Baby-to-Toddler Cardi

Make this wear-anywhere sweater in any color so that baby will always have the perfect layer to keep cozy and comfortable. We've included sizes 12 months to 4 years so you can make a new sweater as baby grows.

Directions are for size 12 months. Changes for sizes 18 months, 24 months, and 4 years are in parentheses.

To Fit: 18 (19, 20, 23)"
Finished Chest: $23(24,25,26)$ "
Finished Length: $11(12,13,14)$ "

Red Heart® Baby TLC ${ }^{\text {TM }}: 3(3,5,5)$ balls 5960
Strawberry Orange.
Knitting Needles: 5 mm [US 8] straight needles, 5 mm [US 8] circular needle 24 " long
Stitch markers, one $3 / 4$ " button, yarn needle.
GAUGE: 18 sts = 4"; 24 rows $=4$ " in St st (knit on Right Side, purl on Wrong Side). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

## Special Stitch

M1 = Make 1 (Increase) - Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and work strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole, [knit or purl as indicated by pattern st].

CARDI
Back
Cast on $49(53,53,59)$ sts.
Ribbing
Row 1 (Right Side): K1, *p1, k1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 2 (Wrong Side): P1, *k1, p1: repeat from * to end of row.
Repeat last 2 rows until piece measures 1 " from beginning, end with a Wrong Side row.
Next Row (Right Side): Knit.
Next Row (Wrong Side): Purl.
Repeat last 2 rows, for St st (knit on Right Side, purl on Wrong Side), until piece measures 11 ( $12,13,14$ )" from beginning, end with a Wrong Side row. Bind off.

## Left Front

Cast on 27 (27, 29, 29) sts.
Work same as back ribbing until piece measures 1 " from beginning, end with a Wrong Side row.
Work even in Stockinette st until piece measures 8 (9, 10,
11)" from beginning, end with a Right Side row.

## Shape Neck

Next Row (Wrong Side): Bind off 4 sts (neck edge), purl to end of row-23 $(23,25,25)$ sts.
Next Row (Right Side): Knit.
Next Row: Bind off 2 sts, purl to end of row-21 (21, 23,
23) sts.

Next Row: Knit.
Repeat last 2 rows $2(2,3,3)$ more times- 17 sts.
Next Row: Bind off 1 st, purl to end of row- 16 sts.
Next Row: Knit.
Repeat last 2 rows $2(2,1,0)$ more time(s)-14 (14, 15, 16) sts remain.

Work even in St st, until piece measures same as back. Bind off.

## Right Front

Cast on 27 (27, 29, 29) sts.
Work same as back ribbing until piece measures 1 " from beginning, end with a Wrong Side row.
Work even in Stockinette st until piece measures 8 (9, 10, 11)" from beginning, end with a Wrong Side row.

## Shape Neck

Next Row (Right Side): Bind off 4 sts (neck edge), knit to end of row-23 $(23,25,25)$ sts.
Next Row (Wrong Side): Purl.
Next Row: Bind off 2 sts, knit to end of row-21 (21, 23,
23) sts.

Next Row: Purl.
Repeat last 2 rows $2(2,3,3)$ more times- 17 sts.
Next Row: Bind off 1 st, knit to end of row-16 sts.
Next Row: Purl.
Repeat last 2 rows $2(2,1,0)$ more time(s) $-14(14,15$, 16) sts remain.

Work even in Stockinette st, until piece measures same as back. Bind off.

## Sleeves (Make 2)

Cast on $26(28,28,30)$ sts.
Work same as back ribbing until piece measures 1 " from beginning, end with a Right Side row.
Next Row (Wrong Side): Purl.
Next Row: Knit.
Next Row: Purl.
Next Row: K1, M1, knit to last st, M1, k1-28 (30, 30, 32) sts. Repeat last 4 rows $9(10,11,11)$ more times-46 (50, 52, 54) sts.

Work even in Stockinette st until piece measures $8(81 / 2,9$, 10)" from beginning. Bind off.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

## Neckband

Row 1: With Right Side facing and circular needle, beginning at right front edge, pick up and k59 $(61,63,65)$ sts evenly spaced across neck edge.
Row 1 (Wrong Side): P1, *k1, p1: repeat from * to end of row.
Row 2 (Right Side): K1, *p1, k1; repeat from * to end of row. Repeat last 2 rows once more. Bind off in ribbing pattern.

## Buttonband

With Right Side facing, pick up and k41 $(43,47,51)$ sts evenly spaced across right front edge. Work ribbing as for neckband. Bind off in ribbing pattern.

## Buttonhole band

With Right Side facing, pick up and k41 $(43,47,51)$ sts evenly spaced across left front edge.
Row 1 (Wrong Side): Work Row 1 of neckband ribbing. Row 2 (buttonhole row): K1, p1, yo, k2tog, k1, *p1, k1; repeat from * to end of row.
Rows 3 and 4: Work Rows 1 and 2 of neckband ribbing. Bind off in ribbing pattern.
Place markers on side edges of fronts and back, 5 ( $51 / 2$, $51 / 2,6$ )" from shoulder seam. Sew top of sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew button to right front edge opposite buttonhole. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{k 2 t o g}=$ knit next 2 sts together; p = purl; yo = yarn over; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
