## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

## BODY

HOOD
With pair of needles and 2 strands of A, cast on 57 (6165) sts.

1st row: (RS). K1. (P1. K1) 3 times. PM. Knit to last 7 sts. PM. K1. (P1. K1) 3 times.
2nd row: P1. (K1. P1) 3 times. Sm. Purl to marker. Sm. P1. (K1. P1) 3 times.
3rd row: P1. (K1. P1) 3 times. Sm. Knit to marker. Sm. P1. (K1. P1) 3 times.
4th row: K1. (P1. K1) 3 times. Sm. Purl to marker. Sm. K1. (P1. K1) twice.

Rep 1st to 4th rows for pat until work from beg measures 9 ( $91 / 2-$ 10)" [20.5 (24-25.5) cm], ending on a WS row.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). With 1 strand each of $\mathbf{A}$ and $\mathbf{B}$, pat to marker. Sm. *SI2. K1. Rep from * to last 1 (20 ) sts. Sl1 (2-0). Sm. Pat to end of row.
2nd row: Pat to marker. Sm. P3 (4-2). SI1. *P2. SI1. Rep from * to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
3rd row: Pat to marker. Sm. Knit to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
4th row: Pat to marker. Sm. Purl to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
5th row: With 2 strands of B, pat to marker. Sm. *SI2. K1. Rep from * to last 1 (2-0) sts. SI1 (2-0). Sm. Pat to end of row.
6th row: Pat to marker. Sm. P3 (4-2). SI1. *P2. SI1. Rep from * to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
7th row: Pat to marker. Sm. Knit to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
8th row: Pat to marker. Sm. Purl to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row. Rep 7th and 8th rows until hood from beg measures 11 (11-12)" [28 (28-30.5) cm], ending on a WS row.

## YOKE

1st row: (RS). Pat to marker. Sm. M1. K4 (5-6). PM. K7 (7-7). PM. K21 (23-25). PM. K7 (7-7). PM. K4 (5-6). M1. Sm. Pat to end of row. 59 (63-67) sts.
2nd row: Pat to first marker. Sm. Purl to last marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
3rd row: Pat to marker. Sm. M1.
*Knit to marker. M1. Sm. K1. M1. Rep from * 3 more times. Knit to marker. M1. Sm. Pat to end of row. 69 (73-77) sts.
4th row: As 2nd row.
5th and 6th rows: As 3rd and 4th rows. 79 (83-87) sts.

## 7th row: With 1 strand each of

 B and C, pat to marker. Sm. M1. (SI2. K1) 3 times. SIO (1-2). M1. Sm. K1. M1. (SI2. K1) 3 times. K1. M1. Sm. K1. M1. (SI2. K1) 8 (8-9) times. Sl0 (1-2). M1. Sm. K1. M1. (SI2. K1) 3 times. K1. M1. Sm. K1. M1. (SI2. K1) 2 (3-3) times. SI2 (01). M1. Sm. Pat to end of row. 89 (93-97) sts.8th row: Pat to first marker. Sm. P2 (0-1). SI1. *P2. SI1. Rep from * to last marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.

9th row: Pat to marker. Sm. M1. *Knit to marker. M1. Sm. K1. M1. Rep from * 3 more times. Knit to marker. M1. Sm. Pat to end of row. 99 (103-107) sts.
10th row: Pat to first marker. Sm. Purl to last marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
11th row: With 2 strands of C pat to marker. Sm. M1. (SI2. K1) 4 (4-5) times. SI1 (2-0). M1. Sm. K1. M1. (SI2. K1) 4 times. SI2. M1. Sm. K1. M1. (SI2. K1) 9 (10-10) times. SI1 (0-2). M1. Sm. K1. M1. (SI2. K1) 4 times. SI2. M1. Sm. K1. M1. (SI2. K1) 4 (4-4) times. SIO (1-2). M1. Sm. Pat to end of row. 109 (113117) sts.

12th row: Pat to marker. Sm. P1 (2-0). SI1. *P2. SI1. Rep from * to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
13th row: Pat to marker. Sm. M1. *Knit to marker. M1. Sm. K1. M1. Rep from * 3 more times. Knit to marker. M1. Sm. Pat to end of row. 119 (123-127) sts.
14th row: Pat to first marker. Sm. Purl to last marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
Rep 13th and 14th rows 1 (2-3) times more. 129 (143-157) sts.

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Next row: Pat to marker. Sm. Knit to next marker. Sm. *K1. M1. Knit to next marker. M1. Sm. Rep from * twice more. Knit to last marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
Next row: Pat to first marker. Sm. Purl to last marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows once more. 141 (155-169) sts.

## Divide Body and Sleeves:

Next row: (RS). Pat to marker. Sm. K19 (22-25). Remove marker. Slip next 25 (27-29) sts onto st holder for left sleeve. Remove marker. K39 (43-47). Remove marker. Slip next 25 (27-29) sts onto st holder for right sleeve. Remove marker. K19 (22-25). Sm. Pat to end of row. 91 (101-111) sts for Bbody.

## Body:

1st row: (WS). Pat to marker. Sm. Purl to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
2nd row: With 1 strand each of C and D, pat to marker. Sm. *SI2. K1. Rep from * to last 2 (0-1) sts before marker. SI2 (0-1). Sm. Pat to end of row.

3rd row: Pat to marker. Sm. P4 (2-3). SI1. *P2. SI1. Rep from * to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
4th row: Pat to marker. Sm. Knit to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
5th row: Pat to marker. Sm. Purl to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
6th row: With 2 strands of $D$, pat to marker. Sm. *SI2. K1. Rep from * to last $2(0-1)$ sts before marker. SI2 (0-1). Sm. Pat to end of row.
7th row: Pat to marker. Sm. P4 (2-3). SI1. *P2. SI1. Rep from * to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
8th row: Pat to marker. Sm. Knit to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
9th row: Pat to marker. Sm. Purl to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row. Rep 8th and 9th rows until body from underarm measures 4 (5-6)" [10 (12.5-15) cm], ending on a WS row.

1st row: (RS). With 1 strand each of $\mathbf{D}$ and $\mathbf{E}$, pat to marker. Sm. *SI2. K1. Rep from * to last 2 (0-1) sts before marker. SI2 (0-1). Sm. Pat to end of row.
2nd row: Pat to marker. Sm. P4 (2-3). SI1. *P2. SI1. Rep from * to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
3rd row: Pat to marker. Sm. Knit to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.

4th row: Pat to marker. Sm. purl to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
5th row: With 2 strands of E, pat to marker. Sm. ${ }^{*}$ SI2. K1. Rep from * to last $2(0-1)$ sts before marker. SI2 (0-1). Sm. Pat to end of row.
6th row: Pat to marker. Sm. P4 (2-3). SI1. *P2. SI1. Rep from * to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row.
7th row: Pat to marker. Sm. Knit to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row. 8th row: Pat to marker. Sm. Purl to marker. Sm. Pat to end of row. Rep 7th and 8th rows until body from underarm measures 6 (810)" [15 (20.5-25.5) cm], ending on a WS Row.

## Border

1st row: (RS). K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
4th row: K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
Rep 1st to 3rd rows once more. Cast off in pat.

## SLEEVES

With double-pointed needles and 2 strands of $\mathbf{C}$, pick up and K1 at underarm, K25 (27-29) from sleeve holder, pick up and K1 at underarm. 27 (29-31) sts. Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd.
1st rnd: Knit.
2nd rnd: K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. ssk. 25 (27-29) sts.
3rd rnd: With 1 strand each of C and $\mathbf{D}, *$ ©SI2. K1. Rep from * to last 1 (0-2) sts. K1 (0-2).
4th rnd: *SI1. K2. Rep from * to last 1 (0-2) sts. K1 (0-2).
5th and 6th rnds: Knit.
7th rnd: With 2 strands of D, *SI2. K1. Rep from * to last 1 (0-2) sts. K1 (0-2).
8th rnd: *SI1. K2. Rep from * to last 1 (0-2) sts. K1 (0-2).
9th rnd: Knit.
10th rnd: K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. ssk. 23 (25-27) sts.
Knit $10(14,18)$ rnds more.
Next rnd: K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. ssk. 21 (23-25) sts.

## Change color:

1st rnd: With 1 strand each of D and E, *SI2. K1. Rep from * to last 0 (2-1) sts. K0 (2-1).

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2nd rnd: *SI1. K2. Rep from * to last 0 (2-1) sts. KO (2-1). 3rd and 4th rnds: Knit. 5th rnd: With 2 strands of $E$, *SI2. K1. Rep from * to last $0(2-1)$ sts. K0 (2-1).
6th rnd: *SI1. K2. Rep from * to last 0 (2-1) sts. KO (2-1).
7th rnd: Knit.
Work even in pat until sleeve from underarm measures $61 / 2$ (810)" [16.5 (20.5-25.5) cm].

Cuff: 1 st rnd: K10 (11-12). K2tog. Knit to end of row. 20 (22-24) sts. 2nd and 3rd rnds: *K1. P1. Rep from * around.
4th and 5th rnds: *P1. K1. Rep from * around.
Rep 2nd to 4th rnds once more. Cast off in pat.

Rep for other sleeve.


## FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.
Fold cast-on edge of hood in half and sew seam at top of hood.
Sew buttons evenly spaced along left front edge. There are no buttonholes. Buttons are fastened through Knit fabric.
