Red Heart® Roll With it Tweed™ (5.29 oz/150 g; 296 yds/271 m)

Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needles 16" [40.5 cm] and 24" [61 cm] long, Set of four sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 4 stitch markers. Tapestry needle.





ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue

 $\mathbf{K} = Knit$

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

together

M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop.

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

St(s) = Stitch(es)

SIZES

To fit chest measurement

2 yrs 21" [53.5 cm] 4 yrs 23" [58.5 cm] 6 yrs 25" [63.5 cm] 8 yrs 26" [66 cm]

Finished chest measurement

2 yrs 24" [61 cm] 4 yrs 26" [66 cm] 6 yrs 28" [71 cm] 8 yrs 30" [76 cm]

GAUGE

16 sts and 22 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: Pullover is knit in 1 piece from neck edge down.



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Beg at neck edge, with smaller, shorter circular needle, cast on **56** (**60-64-68**) sts. PM. Join to beg working in rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around. Rep last rnd of (K2. P2) ribbing **4** (**4**-**6-6**) times more. Remove marker.

Change to larger, shorter circular needle and proceed as follows, switching to longer needle when neccessary:

1st rnd: *K**12** (**13-14-14**). PM. K**4** (**4-4-6**). PM. K**24** (**26-28-28**). PM. K**4** (**4-4-6**). PM. K**12** (**13-14-14**).

2nd rnd: *Knit to 1 st before marker. M1. K1. Slip marker. K1. M1. Rep from * 3 times more. Knit to end of rnd. **64** (**68-72-76**) sts.

3rd rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds **10** (**11-12-13**) times more. **144** (**156-168-180**) sts.

*Knit to next marker. Slip marker. K1. M1. Knit to 1 st before next marker. M1. K1. Slip marker. Rep from * once more. Knit to end of rnd. 148 (160-172) sts.

Next rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds once more. **152** (164-176) sts.

All sizes: You will now have **152** (**164-176-180**) sts, divided as **46** (**50-54-56**) sts each for back and front and **30** (**32-34-34**) sts for each sleeve.

Knit in rnds until work from beg measures 6 (6½-7-7½)" [15 (16.5-18-19) cm].

Divide for Sleeves: Next rnd: *Knit to next marker. Slip next 30 (32-34-34) sts onto scrap yarn for Sleeve. Cast on 2 (2-2-4) sts. Rep from * once more. 96 (104-112-120) sts.

Body

Knit even in rnds until work measures 7½ (8½-9-10)" [19 (21.5-23-25.5) cm] from armhole divide. Change to smaller, longer circular needle.

Next rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K2. P2) ribbing **7** (**7**-**10**-**10**) times more.

Cast off in ribbing.

Sleeves

With larger double-pointed needles, join yarn to right sleeve sts. K30 (32-34-34). Pick up and knit 2 (2-2-4) sts at underarm.

PM in center of these picked up sts to indicate new beg of rnd. **32** (**34-36-38**) sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles.

Knit 10 (12-12-15) rnds even.

Next rnd: K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. ssk. **30** (**32-34-36**) sts.

Knit **3** (5-5-7) rnds even.

Rep last 4 (6-6-8) rnds 5 (4-4-4) times more. 20 (24-26-28) sts. Cont even until Sleeve measures 8½ (10½-11½-12½)" [21.5 (26.5-29-32) cm] from armhole divide. Change to smaller double-pointed needles.

Next rnd: *K1. P1. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K1. P1) ribbing 4 times more.

Cast off in ribbing. Weave in all ends.
